

### Council Briefs

Council did the following.  
Monday night Richmond Hill Councilor Alex Campbell that he had requested Richmond Hill Library Board to set aside necessary funds in its 1964 budget to complete the typing and cataloguing of all bylaws of the town. The library has already done the first 200 bylaws but had to drop the project because of lack of funds.

Delegated the works department to assist the senior citizens in their search for suitable property on which to erect senior citizen housing.

Two sites were suggested, one on a private lane, continuation of Dufferin Street, the other west of Yonge near the cemetery, described by Deputy-reeve Stanley Tinker as landlocked. Reeve Floyd Perkins waxed poetic in taking exception to this site. He said he did not wish to sit in a sun-drenched lot looking at a cemetery. A senior citizen replied, "It would be quiet." Dr. J. P. Wilson was spokesman for the group.

Passed a bylaw to establish as a highway the extension of Enford Road.

Heard Deputy-reeve Tinker announce that the special roads committee of county council is meeting Thursday night, and it is expected to make recommendations re-Bayview to county council on November 19 at 2 o'clock.

Received an offer from Keith Albrighton, president of the Richmond Hill Jaycees to conduct the meeting which follows the close of annual nominations. All nominees are traditionally privileged to address this meeting, and incumbent members of council present reports of the year's work. For the past ten years, Mr. Harry Sayers has presided.

Mr. Albrighton reported the Jaycees had been in touch with Mr. Sayers who had promised to act in an advisory capacity with them. Council thanked the group for the interest but held decision over until they had time to think about it.

Heard that the works commission is going ahead with appraisals of property available to provide a walkway to Crosby School and park.

Went on record as being opposed to a meeting between council and planning board Tuesday night being held in camera. Councillor Seudds said the press has been co-operative in the past in keeping silent when silence was essential. Deputy-reeve Tinker stated that no mention was made of a closed meeting at the last planning board meeting. The mayor was asked to take the matter up with the planning board and inform the press of its decision.

Authorized the chief of police to advertise for a replacement for Police Constable Anthony Fuelling, who has resigned from the force.

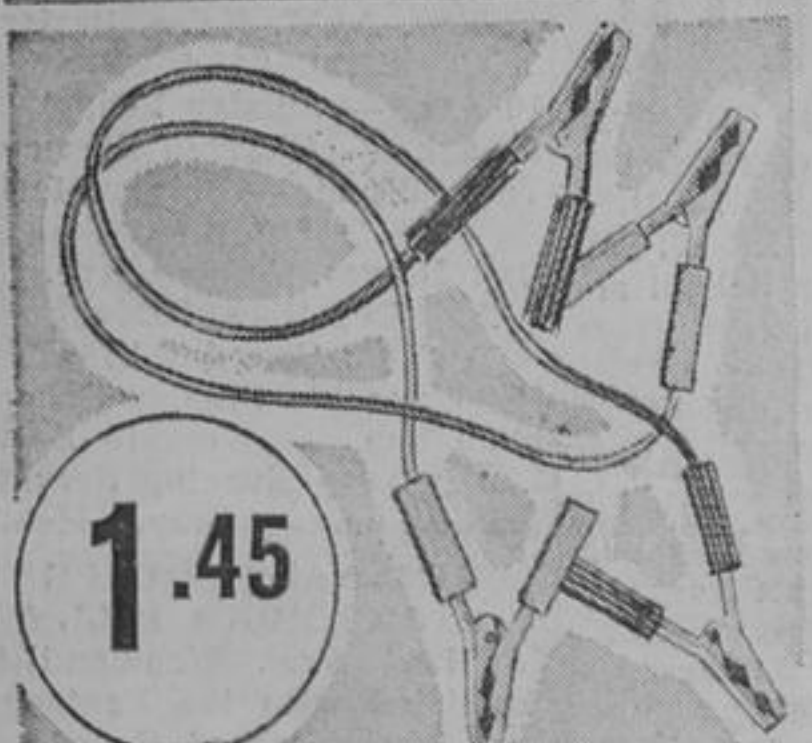

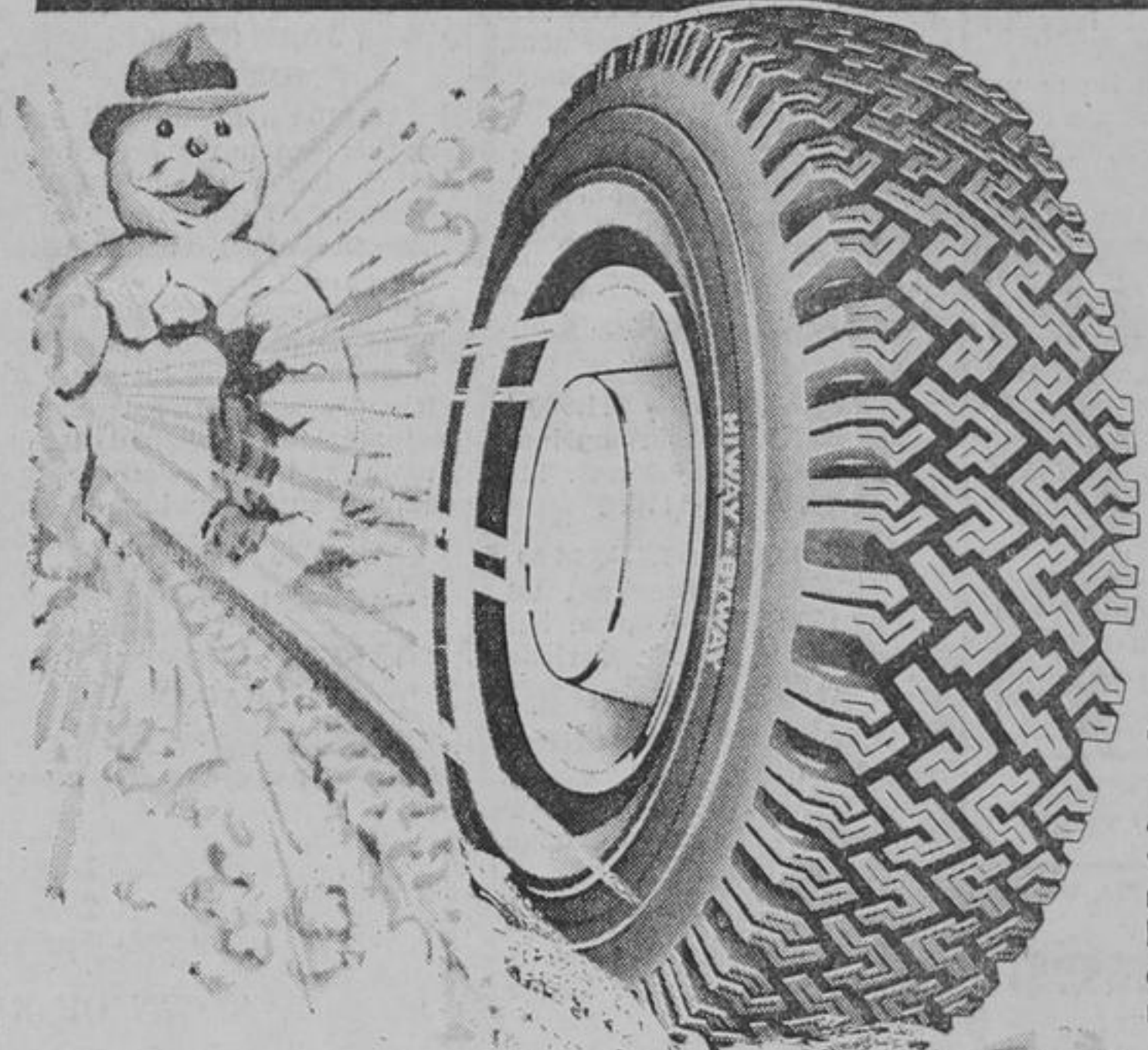
