11 Left Homeless After Don Mills Area Blaze

The neighbourhood was alerted last Thursday morning when the Unionville Fire Brigade was called to a fire at the home of Ron and Ken Tyson, west of Don Mills Road opposite the Gordon Tooley farm, south of John Street. Mrs. Ron Tyson, who lived in the upper storey of the house, noticed smoke about 9:15 a.m., and went to the basement apartment to investigate. There she found a mattress and draperies on fire. Mrs. Ken Tyson who works nights, and Paul, aged 2 and Timothy, 4, were rescued from the blaze, but the family dog died in the fire. The two families, four adults and seven children, were left without clothing, and neighbours, the Red Cross and Buttonville W.I. offered assistance.

Hydro Poles On Private Property Need Re-locating

Hydro poles on Carville Road, relocated in 1956 to make way for road reconstruction, were inadvertently placed on private property and have to be uprooted again. According to a request to Vaughan Council, from the Ontario Hydro Commission, the township will have to assume part of the financial obligation to move the poles at a cost of \$275. Council agreed and asked Hydro to relocate the poles on a line established by the Vaughan engineer.
