WEST DON SEWER AREA (NUMBER 1) Construction of a SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT and TRIBUTARY SEWER, as follows: Construction of SEWERS, on:

- 1. KEELE STREET, from approximately 500 feet North of the South limit of Lot 8 to Langstaff Road. - Approx. length - 3,600'. 2. NEW STREET (Lot 8) from Keele Street to New Street, approximately 2300' east. 3.
