**St. Paul's
New Church**

St. Paul's Lutheran Church will hold its first worship service Sunday in its new building on Bayview Avenue.

Sunday's worship service will begin at 11 a.m. Sunday school classes will meet at 9:30 a.m. in the building.

Richmond Hill's Lutherans have been meeting in Walter Scott School since March, 1960. Their new church has been under construction since mid-June.

The building is the first phase of total planned construction. It provides a nave (worship area) seating 140, classrooms, office, pullman kitchen, washrooms and utility room.

A large free-standing cross marks the church site. The building is beside Bayview Secondary School, just south of Centre St.

Dedication ceremonies for the new church are being planned for later this fall. Still to be completed are the coloured glass window in the chancel, the pipe organ and the parking lot paving.

Architect for the church is Karl Kruschen of Waterloo. Contractor is William Wolfe of Clarkson.

Chairman of the building committee is Philip Limpert. His fellow committeemen are Philip Barth, Joseph Miller, Pastor Albert Myers, Ross Percival and Victor Solich.

The congregation of about two hundred souls was organized in 1962 by the Rev. Albert E. Myers. Pastor Myers will preach the opening-day sermon.
