

### Hill Death - Free But Accidents Pile Up To Start Year

Richmond Hill Police Department is the only area force starting 1965 with a fatality-free slate in 1964.  
But the new year got off to a flying start with about a dozen accidents from January 1 on in the Hill, Markham and Vaughan.  
The local motorist's menace (Yonge Street and Markham Road) chalked up its first pin on Chief R. P. Robbin's traffic map at 4.20 p.m. January 1 when cars driven by Mary Jean Shelton, 35, 212 Church Street South and Edward Archer, 28, of Scarboro collided. Mrs. Shelton has been charged with failing to yield the right of way, police said. Damage was \$100. No one was injured.

The corner has been the scene of 32 accidents last year and dozens of minor incidents that weren't reportable.

"We're off to a great start," Chief Robbins said Monday.

On January 2, around 7 p.m. a car driven by Tobias Murphy, 21, of 239 Beechy Drive, rolled over three times before it came to rest on Newkirk Road near Crosby Avenue. Murphy, uninjured, was charged with impaired driving, police said.  
At 11 a.m. January 2, at Yonge Street south of Lorne Avenue damage was \$90 following a collision between cars driven by Gerardus Teffer, Garden Avenue, Richvale and Richard Collyer of Willowdale. No one was injured.

Damage was \$2,000 following a two-car crash which sent two Richmond Hill boys to hospital with head and facial lacerations.

Peter Barnett, 10, and his brother, John, 11, were passengers in their father Harold Barnett's car when it was in collision with one driven by Treanor Canning of Concession 3 Markham. Canning was charged with failing to stop at the Newkirk Road-Centre Street intersection.

In Vaughan, a series of minor accidents ended the year.

On December 30 at 8.10 a.m. on Bathurst Street and Mill Street, damage was \$150 following a collision between cars driven by Bregan Cutler, 17, of Pemberton Road, Richvale, and Reginald Cass, 47, 90 Evahill Crescent, Richmond Hill. No one was injured.

Also on Wednesday, at 8.15 a.m. at the entrance to the Vaughan municipal office, damage was \$150 following a collision between cars driven by Donald R. MacDonald, 51, of Calvin Chambers Road and Arthur Foster, 52, of Wright Street, Richmond Hill. No one was injured.

At 9.55 a.m. the same morning, at Keele Street half a mile north of Highway 7 at the entrance to the GNB cars driven by John Gardner, 20, of Alexander Street, Toronto and Frank Vincent, 26, of Willowdale collided. Damage was \$300. No one was injured.

Damage was \$300 when cars driven by John Greenfield of Baker Avenue, Richmond Hill and Leona Marie Cuddihy of Pemberton Road, Richvale were involved in an accident on Carrville Road.

Vaughan's first accident for 1965 was last Saturday at Keele Street south of Maple when 72-year-old driver William Henry Noble of Keele Street, lost control on the slippery road and ended up in a ditch after striking a pole. Damage was \$800 but he wasn't injured.

Police Chief James Davidson said the Christmas-New Year holiday was relatively quiet with no charges laid for impaired driving despite 50 or 60 spot checks made.

In Markham, things were quiet this year with only minor accidents reported.

At 43 minutes after midnight January 1, the first accident on the township roads occurred at 16th Avenue and the 10th Concession, when Douglas Arthur Knapp, 20, of Scarboro, was thrown from his car and then pinned beneath it.

A tow truck freed him and he and his passenger, Raymond Francisco, 19, were both taken to Scarboro General Hospital with abrasions and lacerations. Both youths were released the next day.

On January 2, in a single car accident, Roy William Law of Toronto was uninjured when his car went into the ditch on the Sixth Concession and Gormley Town Line and rolled over. Damage was \$300.

A Toronto woman, Martha E. Kennedy was struck as she crossed Don Mills Road north of Steeles Avenue around 11.15 a.m. Sunday morning by a car driven by John Sliz Jr. of Agincourt. She was taken to Scarboro General Hospital with a broken leg and arm.
