Montessori Wins Taxation Fight

Markham Township's Montessori Private School has finally won its battle against tax assessment in the township. At its regular Monday meeting this week, council approved a report of its general committee recommending that the school, which first appealed its assessment last year, be declared exempt from municipal taxation, and that the township's appeal against it not be pursued further. A court of revision had ruled earlier that it was without justification in the matter, as the school was appealing whether it came under the meaning of the assessment act and not the amount of its assessment. A subsequent appeal to a county court judge was adjourned sine die (without date). In making its decision to exempt the school, council reviewed a letter from Township Solicitor J. D. Lucas, in which he stated that the school had proved its incorporation as a non-profit organization and was therefore exempt from taxation.
