Consequently adoption has become so much a part of the culture that the press and TV now regularly carry adoption arrangements. It is a well known fact that many adopted children have grown into some of our most

After that the child must be restored to his parents or guardian if they have a suitable home and good conditions for the child's welfare; if not the child may become a permanent ward. (2) A permanent ward. A permanent ward becomes the child of the CAS and the parent loses him permanently. He becomes available for adoption. (3) A non-ward. The CAS feels they should be among other children with similar backgrounds, but wants to avoid placing them in an institution. One solution is the group home. This is where a couple with enough space will take in a group of six, usually older children. The CAS is also seeking group homes for children who require special care.

by CAS. The remainder are arranged privately through lawyers and doctors and most of these are children related to the adoptive parents. But the CAS is brought into the picture on all adoptions handled in the province. As the provincial governments agent, its job is to recommend to the court in favor or against each adoption before it becomes

The Department of Public Welfare acts as a clearing house in adoption cases for the 55 Children's Aid Societies. This is particularly useful in the adoption of hard-to-place children, those who are older,

Catholic CAS in three cities, Toronto, Hamilton and Windsor. Anywhere else, one should apply in the

area of residence. Religious barriers mean little in private adopt tions. It is up to the father, or if he is not known or available, the mother, to decide the religion of the child. If responsible parents consent to cross religious lines and the adoptive parents agree, there is no legal barrier. To arrange a private adoption, the natural parent should get in touch with a lawyer

but it is against the law for anyone to accept or make any kind of payment for the exchange of a child.

In adoptions through the CAS, after making the initial appointment, prospective parents may have to wait six to twelve months for a child. The child is then on probation "at home" for six months, after which the adoption may become final.
