Salaries Likely To Go Up In 1966 SAt Thornhaven

Officials at the 39-pupil Thornhaven School for Retarded Children are hoping for higher salary rates in 1966 under the year-old provincial-municipality

Starting salary for teachers presently is \$2600 with the maximum set at \$3400. There are four fulltime teachers at the school including the prin-

This information along with a general resume of 1965 school activities was presented to members of Richmond Hill Council last week by Chairman John Graham of Richmond

> Mr. Graham said the low salary scale was a carry over from the days when the school operated on a voluntary basis.

"We're expecting some guidance from the Department of Education on salary scales," he said. This was the first year that

the Ontario Government and municipalities financed operation of retarded children schools on 80 and 20 percent contribution respectively. Mr. Graham said this year's

operation costs were kept within the budget but would increase considerably in the new year. The budget figures totalled \$48,623 with expenses estimated

at \$43,400. Cost to Richmond Hill was \$2,371.90. "Two factors which will cause the budget increase next year," he said, "will be requests to raise teachers' salaries to within a starting range of \$3000 to \$3500 and the fact that our transportation bill will be \$3000

Transportation is provided by Langdon's Coach Lines of King City under contract.

"An application will be forthcoming," Mr. Graham said, "to increase the transport fee from the present amount of \$1500 per month to \$1800 due to an added noon day run occasioned by an increase of half-day students. These buses travel approximately 200 miles per day." The school has 10 children

from Richmond Hill with the remainder transported from Markham and Vaughan Townships, Thornhill, Stouffville, the south part of Whitchurch Township, Markham Village, Highway 400. There are three pupils from Scarboro and four from North York.

"Up to five additional students may be admitted to Thornhaven," Mr. Graham said, "starting with the January term subject to acceptance by the admissions board.

Mr. Graham added that facilities at the school are sufficient and will be for two years but said that some expansion will be required in the years to come. "We believe in giving ad-

vance warning," he said. Makeup of the Thornhaven school comprises:

Thornhaven Admission Board, Mrs. I. Webb, chairman; Dr. Paul E. Perry D. Psych; Gordon McIntyre, public school superintendent and F. M. Weiss, separate school inspector.

Authority members are Chairman Graham, two year appointment; and members, W. A. Dowell Vaughan Township two year appointment; Dr. C. W. Birkett and Mrs. D. King, of Richmond Hill. All were appointed by Richmond Hill Coun-

Dr. Birkett of Maple was appointed for one year. Mrs. King is completing one year as a replacement for Pat Smith. Associate members are C. Herbener, of Willowdale completing two years as a replacement for D. Brown, and E. Jennings, of Richmond Hill a one-year appointment.

Mr. Graham concluded by saying his report was a "happy" one and he had no complaints to put before council.
