

**Two Unhurt Mkm Twp. Plane Crash**

Two men escaped injury Saturday afternoon after their four-seater Cessna aircraft crashed just after takeoff from Buttonville Airport in Markham Township.

Involved in the accident were Mike Dorey, 33, of Downsview, a licensed instructor and pilot of the plane, and his passenger, Ian Speller, 52, of Don Mills.

According to Markham Township Police, the plane developed engine trouble after clearing the trees at the end of the runway, and crashed into some soft mud near Highway 7 on Concession 3.

Damage to the plane, which was later towed back to the airport, was estimated at \$3,000.

Cause of the engine trouble was blamed on contaminated fuel.

**Two Girls Accosted**

**Charge Man With Impersonating An Officer**

The alleged wooing of two girls by false pretences has brought about the arrest of a 25-year-old Richmond Hill man.

According to police, the girls were stopped by a man, who had been cruising by them in his car, as they walked through a service station lot early Saturday morning.

The man identified himself as a police officer and asked the girls their names, addresses and phone numbers. Then he grabbed one of the girls and tried to force her into his car on the pretext he was taking her to headquarters, police said.

The girl managed to get away and then called police after taking the man's licence number.

Arrested was Raymond Chislain, 334 McConvey Drive, who has been charged with impersonating a police officer and with common assault.

**From \$500 To \$1,000**

**No Decision Made On Motion To Increase Lot Fees In Mkhm Twp**

A recommendation by Markham Township Planning Board that township lot fees be increased from \$500 to \$1,000 on future residential lots, ran into some opposition before finally being received by council at a meeting held Tuesday evening of last week.

"I'll never be a party to such wholesale robbery, which is

what this amounts to," said Councillor Allan Sumner.

He said that, if there were some provincial legislation that would relieve residents of new subdivisions of existing costs, he would agree to it, but didn't feel they should have to pay an extra \$500 as well.

Mr. Sumner said it would mean people in the new subdivisions wouldn't "get a nickel's worth" out of what they were paying.

Deputy-reeve S. J. Gadsby said he thought council should approve the increase and decide later what to do with it. He said also, that he didn't think the increase should apply to old lots.

Reeve Stewart Rumble said council couldn't charge for one and not the other; it would be applied to the whole township.

Mr. Sumner failed to get a seconder for his motion to defer the matter and council subsequently agreed to a motion by Councillor Charles Hoover to receive the report.

Council also: Agreed to a request from the York County Branch, Canadian Mental Health Association to campaign for funds in the township during Mental Health Week May 1 to 7.

Agreed to a request from Grandview-Highland Community Association to close off Doncaster Avenue between Henderson and Meadowview Avenues from 9 am to 1 pm May 22, in order to stage a soap box derby during the association's Centennial Jamboree.

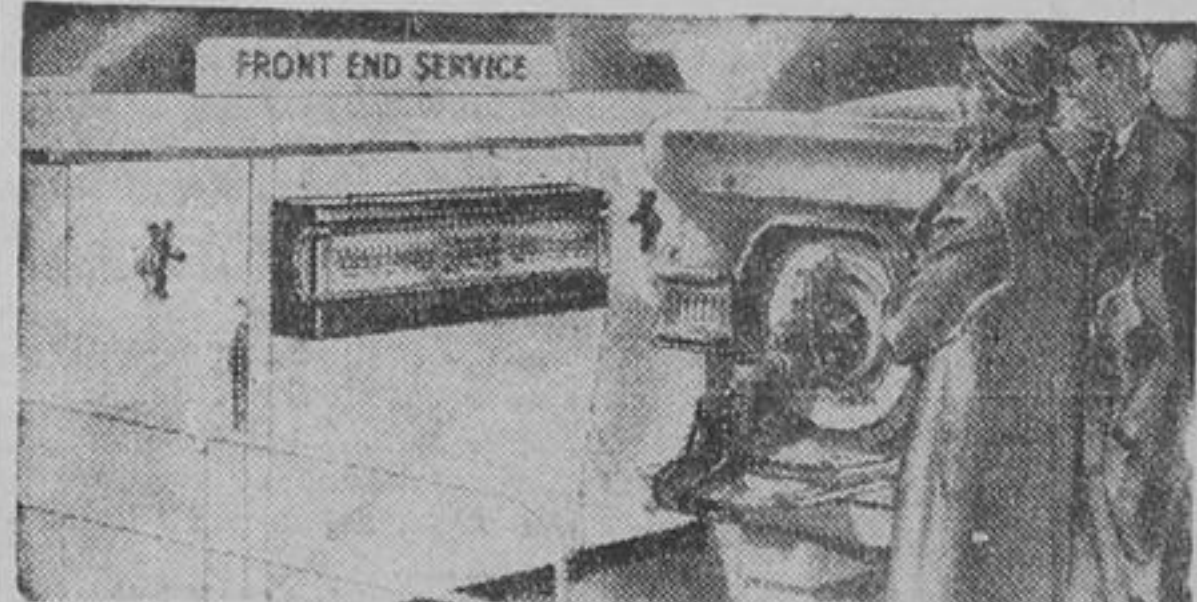
