**Order Came To Canada In 1828**  
**July 12 Orange Parades Recall 1691 Battle Of Boyne Victory**

Orangemen from York North celebrated the grand and glorious Twelfth of July by participating in the walk at Stayner. Included was a representation from Victoria LOL, Richmond Hill.

The founding of the Orange Order in England goes back to 1688 when William of Orange and his wife Mary ascended to the throne. Three years later, at the Battle of the Boyne, Protestant William defeated the Roman Catholic father-in-law James II of England (James VIII of Scotland). James had fled the throne when William and Mary were invited to take over the monarchy. The battle decided for ever that the English monarchy would be Protestant.

The Orange Order came to Canada in 1828 brought by Ogle R. Gowan to strengthen the Protestant faith and provide a medium for British connection wherever British subjects were to be found. There had been lodges in Canada as early as 1812 and 1814, but it was not until Gowan's arrival that the order took form as an organization.

On January 1, 1830, the Grand Lodge of British America was founded in the town hall of Brockville, with Gowan becoming grand master, a position he held for 18 years.

When William Lyon Mackenzie stirred up the rebellion of 1837 Orangemen turned out to defend the established order of government. Gowan, himself, was wounded three times at the Battle of the Windmill near Prescott. After this uprising, Orangemen were among those who advocated confederation and protection for Canadian industries, and continued

**Dr. Ramsay Armitage**  
**Anglican Book Of Common Prayer Theme At Marylake This Sunday**

Rev. Dr. Ramsay Armitage of St. Stephen's Anglican Church, Maple, will be the eighth speaker in the interfaith series, Contact '67, being held at the Augustinian Shrine at King City. Dr. Armitage will speak on "Anglicans and the Book of Common Prayer," August 6 at 7:30 pm. He is recognized as an expert on the Anglican prayerbook, having collaborated in its revision.

Besides having served as rector and dean of several important pastoral charges for more than 25 years, he was principal of Wycliffe College, Toronto, from 1940 to 1959. He also served overseas as chaplain from 1914-18 with the Toronto Regiment, 3rd Battalion.

Eight institutions have recognized his scholarly achievements by awarding him honorary doctorates and his country has bestowed on him the Military Cross.

Contact '67 is sponsored by the Augustinian Community at Marylake Shrine under the general title of "Man at Prayer". It is investigating the meaning of prayer in the major faiths and its relevancy to contemporary man. So far a Buddhist, Jew, United Church, Eastern Catholic, Roman Catholic and a Muslim have explained prayer from their point of view. The audience has a chance to ask questions after the lecture and to meet the speakers informally.

Two additional lectures which were not included in the original brochure will be heard. Sister Regina Ann, of the theological faculty of St. Basil's Seminary, will speak on "Catholic Worship and Renewal", August 13 at 7:30 pm; Rev. Edmund Colledge, OSA, formerly professor of Liverpool University, England, and an internationally known expert on the English and Continental Mystics, will speak on "Mysticism and the Mystics", August 20. There will also be an organ concert by Frank Iacino, August 16 at 8:30 pm.
