Replaces Sam Neill

John Schouten New S.S. Trustee

John Schouten of 285 Elmwood Avenue was unanimously appointed to the Richmond Hill Separate School Board July 25 by a vote of trustees to fill the unexpired term of Trustee Sam Neill. Mr. Neill has moved to London where he will be supervising the resource centre of the University of Western Ontario. He was elected in December 1965 for a two year term, which expires at the end of this year. Mr. Neill's resignation was submitted to the previous board meeting on July 4.

PORTABLES
The board received a letter of thanks from Thornhaven Education Authority for provision of a portable classroom at a reasonable rental. Trustee John Pennyfather reported that the portable (from St. Joseph's School) had been put into excellent condition and the exterior painted before it was moved.

ANNEXATION
The board agreed that it would have no objection to Richmond Hill annexing 250 acres north of Elgin Mills Road East if there is assurance it will be developed as industrial and commercial land. Separate school children from a limited residential development could be accommodated in existing classrooms, according to school population figures now available. The trustees would object to any major residential development, it was agreed. Business Administrator Jack Matthews was instructed to ascertain what assurance ratepayers will have that the land will be zoned industrial and commercial. If any large residential development is planned, he was instructed to prepare a brief to be presented to the Ontario Municipal Board at its hearing August 1, and call an emergent meeting of the board for its approval.

A portable from Our Lady Help of Christians Separate School has also been leased to the York Central District High School Board.

In both cases the lease requires that the portables be returned in as good condition.

Timmins Cleric Dies On Train Trip

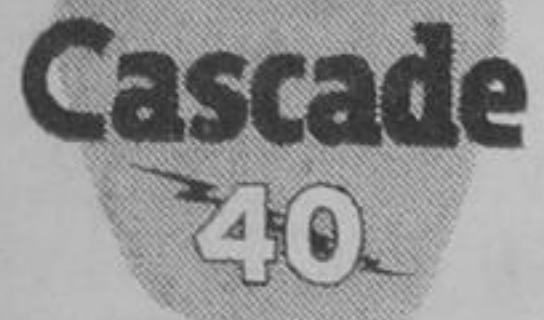
A Timmins minister, en route to Toronto by CNR train for a holiday was found dead in his compartment near Concord July 27.
