Fon keeps one thing from the past and that is his ambition to honor his father's memory by carrying on the good works of Bing Lew.

THE BUSINESS MAN Fon hopes to get a cocktail licence because of the modern trend to enjoy a drink at dinner time. However, he emphasizes, "It's the food that's important. Food is my main selling point."

Even the menus will be new. Fon will engage the services of those who specialize in Cantonese food. So much of what we have come to know as Chinese food does not have Chinese origin. This will be changed and you will have the opportunity to become acquainted with authentic Chinese cook-

I've often wondered why people turn so eagerly to Chinese food.
