

Compiling a total of 997 votes in the entire County of York, Con Thompson of Essex Avenue, Richmond Hill, will represent the separate school supporters of the county on the York County Board of Education. Mr. Thompson is a former member of Richmond Hill Separate School Board and is at present on the board of Brebeuf High School in North York. He will only vote on secondary and

retarded school matters. John Pennyfather, also of Richmond Hill, amassed 846 votes in the county-wide election and Sydney Woolnough of Highland Park in Markham Township received a total of

632 votes. Teachers Learn Art, Craft Skill

Fifty-seven teachers from Markham Township School Area No. 1 and surrounding areas attended an art workshop December 3, 4 and 5 at the 16th Avenue Public School The workshop was conducted by Miss Dorothy Wiese, who has taught extensively and holds a specialist in arts degree from Eastern Michigan University of Ypsilanti.

The teachers spent 15 hours of their own time learning about modern creative art education and some of its materials and tools. These techniques included the use of crayons, water colors, poster paints, colored chalks and modeling clay. The teacher-students also worked with paper, paste and other materials to gain three-dimensional effects, all activities which can be used in classroom teaching.


