

New School Natural Science Cost \$150,000

A \$150,000 natural science school will be built next year at Claremont Conservation Area in Pickering Township. Metro Region Conservation Authority approved the project last week. The school will accommodate 50 Metro school children at a time for week-long stays. The authority also decided to apply for a licence to serve wine and beer with meals at Pioneer Village's Halfway House Restaurant, and to establish overnight trailer camps at Clairville and Feticot Creek Conservation Areas.

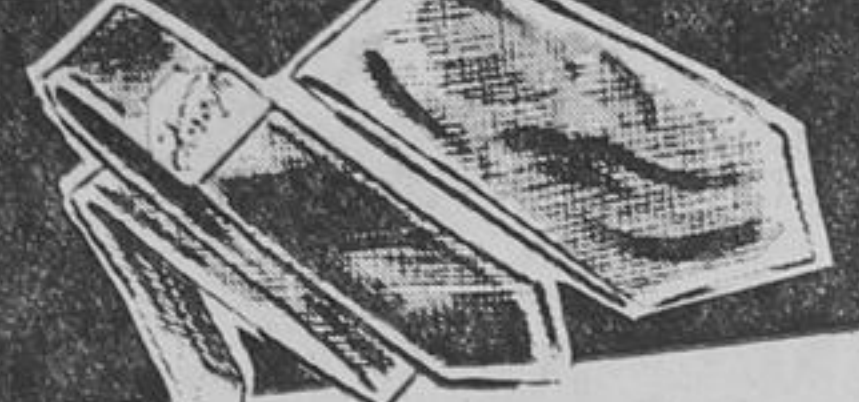
