A half dozen persons summoned in error to appear in Provincial Court at Richmond Hill waited in vain for over an hour Thursday morning of last week for their cases to be cal-


However, no court was held since presiding provincial judges were at the Holiday Inn in Hamilton attending a two-day conference.


