**Awarded Scholarship**

David Ross Scrimger, 71 Centre Street West, Richmond Hill, a first year student at the School of Mines of the Northern College of Applied Arts and Technology, Halleybury Campus, has been awarded the Falconbridge Nickel Company Scholarship. It was announced recently. He stood eighth in a class of 46.

David attended MacKillop Public School and graduated from Bayview Secondary School in 1969.

His interest in mining is natural since his father, Ross Scrimger, is employed in the mining industry and David was born in a small northern mining community. In the summer of 1969 he worked as a prospector's assistant in Northwestern Canada and the Yukon and in 1968 was engaged in prospecting and exploration in the Coppermine area, reached only by helicopter.
