 11 and now, at 16 she is an unmarried mother and a prostitute. The boy she is living with beats her, too.

Anyone can become a parent, said Miss Callwood. "This girl will take her baby back to the rooming house and she will batter it. Every year, 100,000 alcoholics take babies home and do sweet things with them. The children are tortured, made pervers, driven insane. These are the kids in Digger House."

"A baby should go home to two people who are glad he was born. He needs to be loved by two people who will give him confidence and motivation."

In a study of the intellectual stimulation of babies, it has been shown that a normal healthy baby shows interest at one month.

"This is how people learn. Middle class mothers play games with their babies. For some reason 'peek' is very important. It stimulates the intelligence."

Half of the factors that intellectually stimulate a child are those that are introduced in the first four years, said Miss Callwood. The normal child she called "Johnny".

In contrast she talked about "Charlie" — battered, unloved and scared. Never played with, he learned early to shut off noise and pain, committing a form of suicide in cutting off the "God" in him.

When Johnny and Charlie start to school, the speaker continued, everyone likes Johnny — the teacher, the principal, the YMCA.

But nobody likes Charlie. He is a "Bluebird", sitting on "that side" of the classroom and manoeuvred into an opportunity class.

"If you are a Charlie, you are a pants presser at six years old."

There are children in the Metro and surrounding area who have never eaten salad, said Miss Callwood. They will react in one way or another — they will be angry and rebellious — about 80 percent of the people now in jail come from this type of environment.

Or they can go passive, mentally ill, become drug users and get into trouble too. They are arrested on drug charges, become unmarried mothers. They may be shunted from foster home to foster home, and to greater despair, and all along the way they are confronted with people who ask "Why aren't you doing better?"

Johnny may have long hair, even try drugs, but it is utterly insignificant. He tries it to show his daring, "to freak out" his parents, to be different. Eighty percent of the "Johnny's" who try drugs do it once or twice, and they never do it again. But Charlie will not be helped. He is broken-hearted.

Miss Callwood reminded the audience of adults that during the depression everyone was hungry and it did not matter, because that was the way it was. During the war everybody knew what was black and what was white, who were the good guys and who were the bad guys.

"We know that if we have a house, we have it made, even if we have an unhappy marriage."

But today, she said, everyone is scared. "We are all coming apart. Family service is only the beginning. We have got to have hostels for the homeless kids, more day care centres, more humane school systems — at least up to the age of 11. There are a lot of kids who have never known an adult who liked him, who loved him."

She commented on a report that York County Board of Education is considering experimenting with an "authoritarian" type of school.

"I thought that we had got away from all that — from the idea that to hurt people will improve their character. In 1890 an eight-year-old was imprisoned in Canada to improve his character."

In conclusion, Miss Callwood said, "If we knew there were 20 kids at the bottom of a mine shaft, no one would say, 'Are they clean? Are they educated? Do they have long hair? Do they wear beads?' We would just get them out."

"We have 100,000 kids at the bottom of that mine in the Metro area, and we have to get them out. It is called 'The Golden Rule'."

Miss Callwood was thanked by Rev. Robert Smith of Richmond Hill United Church, chairman of the meeting, and a member of the steering committee which has been working for more than a year planning for the opening of a family service centre.

A slate of officers and board of directors was approved by the meeting, and it was announced that a centre to serve the Thornhill-Richmond Hill area, from Steeles Avenue to Oak Ridges, and from Don Mills Road to Highway 400, will open on a part time basis in April.
