Assessment Revision Will Lift All Of York County The Order Of St. John

(Continued from Page 1) wants to appeal his assessment. This extra time is provided by the provision that the assessment notices be mailed 15 days before the date for the return of the assessment roll instead of at the same time.

Market Valuation Is Certain But There's Hope Of Tax Hike Cushion

The program for putting all of York County's property assessment on a market value basis will continue unchanged, according to recent statements by Municipal Affairs Minister Darcy McKeough and provincial assessment department spokesmen.

But there is some hope there may be some relief for property owners who suffer major tax increases because of the new market value assessment. On the other hand, those in line for major tax reductions may only get their cuts bit by bit over a period of years.

Mr. McKeough said in the Legislature there could be a slowdown of as much as one year in the provincial program to reform the assessment system and standardize it on the market value basis by 1975.

market value. Only then would it have enough information to predict any undesirable effects, and be able to take action to deal with them in realistic terms.

Mr. Madgett said there are about 417,000 properties in his area, covering Halton, Peel, York, Ontario, Simcoe and Muskoka.

Mr. McKeough has said that a second program may result where the tax shift is from one class of property to another, as from commercial and industrial properties to residential properties.

Second — Taxing business properties on 100% of market value assessment, while keeping business taxes at current rates and taxing residential properties at less than 100% of assessment.

Mr. McKeough said in the Legislature that municipalities that already have market value assessment will be able to phase in tax increases and decrease over a period of years.
