

Diabetes Clinic Is Big Success Lions Declare

When Richmond Hill Lions Club sponsored its first diabetes detection clinic in the Lions' Hall last week, 131 people came out for the simple blood tests that will tell whether or not they have diabetes.

Arranged by the health and welfare committee of the club under Chairman Grant Marshall, the clinic was run by Miss Verna Smyth, associate director of nursing for York-Oshawa District Health Unit, and a team of six nurses. Supplies and equipment for testing were provided by the unit.

People came from as far afield as Maple and Thornhill, as well as from Richmond Hill. Mr. Marshall reports, and those who show a positive reaction to the test will be referred to the care of their family doctor.

The committee, which includes Dr. James Langstaff and Lion Don Andrews, plans to have a similar clinic next year, said Mr. Marshall, who is delighted with the response to the initial effort.

Counterfeit \$10 Passed Here
