

**Beat The Summer Heat
By Visiting One Of
13 Conservation Areas**

With warm summer weather now making its presence felt, the Metro Conservation Authority is expecting record attendances in its 13 conservation areas.

These areas provide impressive-sized "greenbelts" in the 1,000 square mile watershed region administered by the Authority, and annually attract more than one million visitors for daytime recreational pursuits.

Most of the areas provide swimming, hiking, picnicking, while some have boating, fishing and weekend family camping.

The newest area is the Claireville Conservation Area which provides 1,600 acres of open space for public enjoyment. It is located just south of Highway 50 and Steeles Avenue, and surrounds the Claireville Dam and Reservoir which the authority built under its flood control and water conservation program.

Here is a list of the summer time facilities for the public and the areas and their locations:

Albion Hills — Five miles north of Bolton on Highway 50 — group camping, family camping, swimming, fishing, nature trails and refreshment facilities.

Black Creek — Home of the famous Black Creek Pioneer Village, at Jane Street and Steeles Avenue West, picnicking in the area, and then a leisurely tour of the village, refreshment booth, and a restaurant in the Half Way House. More than 20 restored buildings to visit.

Boyd Area — Just north of Woodbridge, group camping, swimming, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Bruce's Mill — Two miles east of Don Mills road on the Gormley-Stouffville Road, group camping, swimming, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Claremont Area — In Pickering Township, 1 1/2 miles north of Highway 7 on Sideroad 10, group camping, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Claireville Area — South of Highway 50 and Steeles Avenue, group camping, swimming, boating, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Cold Creek — Located between Bolton and Nobleton on the King Sideroad, primarily for sportsmen and naturalists, has trap, rifle and archery ranges and a famous black spruce bog, also family camping, and refreshment facilities.

Glen Haffy — Located near Mono Mills and Hwy. 9, group camping, boating, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Greenwood Area — Four miles north of Pickering on the Greenwood Road, group camping, swimming, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Heart Lake — East of Brampton, group camping, swimming, boating, fishing, nature trail and refreshment facilities.

Humber Trails — Located south of the King City Sideroad just off Nobleton and west of Highway 400, group camping and fishing.

Palgrave Forest and Wildlife Area — Located north of Highway 50 to Sideroad 25 west to the Humber river and north 1 1/2 miles — fishing and nature trail.

Lower Rouge Area — Located at the mouth of the Rouge River in Pickering Township, swimming, fishing and refreshment facilities.

A Provincial Police Officer testified he stopped the bus on Highway 11 south of Highway 7 after noticing the tires were bald.



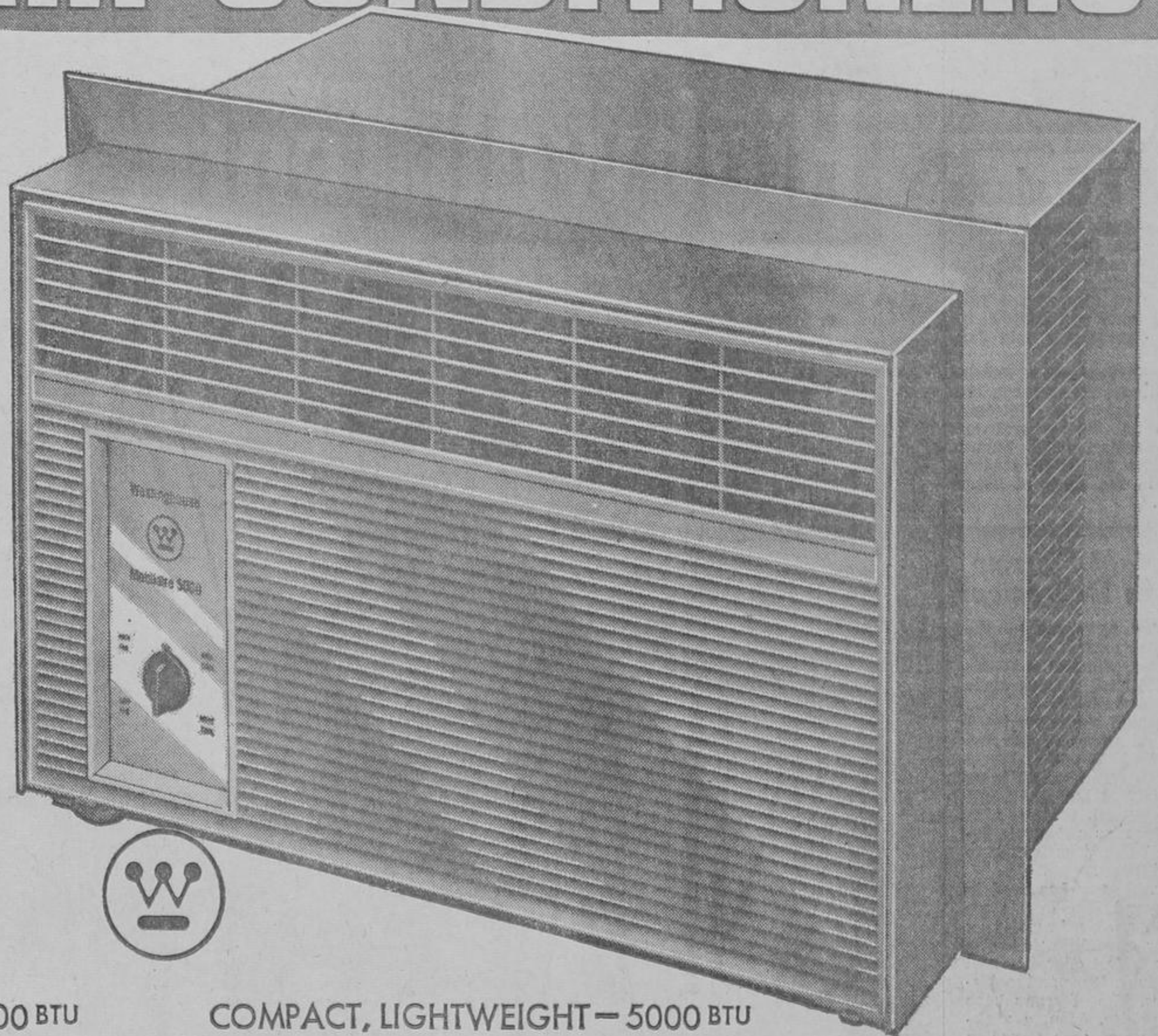
