

**Plan Family Outing  
Guided Tours, Hikes  
This Saturday, Sunday**

The general public is invited to take a guided parks and conservation hike on Sunday which will be jointly sponsored by the Metro Conservation Authority and the Metro Parks Department.

The two hour hike will get underway at 2 pm and will cover a portion of the scenic Highland Creek Park. It will commence from the Highland Creek Park Morningside Area. The Morningside Area is north of Kingston Road and south of Ellesmere Avenue, west of Morningside Avenue.

The hike will be conducted by Kenneth Higgs, RPF, the authority's director of operations, and Tommy Thompson, commissioner of parks for Metro.

Highlights of the hike will be history of the Highland Creek, a description of the geology, an outline of conservation measures that have been completed by the authority, and a description of recreational facilities which have been constructed or are being planned by Metro Parks Department.

The authority will also be holding its last conducted hikes of the season in some of its conservation areas this Sunday. They are as follows:

**Albion Hills Conservation Area** — Five miles north of Bolton, on Highway 50 at 2 pm and 3:30 pm.

**Boyd Area** — Just north of Woodbridge, on the Woodbridge-Kleinburg Road, at 2 pm and 3:30 pm.

**Bruce's Mill** — Two miles east of Don Mills Road on the Gormley Road in Markham Township, at 2 pm and 3:30 pm.

**Greenwood Area** — Four miles north of Pickering on the Greenwood Road, at 2 pm.

**Claremont Area** — In Pickering Township, 1 1/2 miles north of Highway 7 on Sideroad 10 at 4 pm.

**Court News**

**Charge Kettleby Man  
For Dangerous Driving  
And Assaulting Police**

Donald Fallis, 26, of RR 1, Kettleby in Richmond Hill Provincial Court October 15 was charged with dangerous driving and assaulting two Richmond Hill police officers.

The offences are alleged to have taken place earlier the same day.

Fallis was arrested by Constables Kenneth Paton and Leroy Chance. These are the officers he is charged with assaulting.

Fallis was remanded on \$500 personal bail to appear in court again on October 29.

A Downsview man was committed for trial by judge and jury on a fraud charge after a preliminary hearing before Judge Russell Pearce in Richmond Hill Provincial Court October 15.

Charged is Randy Zoltan of Downsview, former operator of a service station on the northwest corner of Steeles Avenue West and Dufferin Street in Vaughan Township.

Frederick Axson of 146 Mintwood Road, Willowdale testified that he paid Zoltan \$1,200 and was to receive an army surplus tank truck.

He said he didn't get the truck, and after being given a series of excuses, finally found the service station empty and Zoltan gone.

The testimony involved three vehicles. The first was a truck that Axson said he originally agreed to purchase.

The second was a truck that was supposed to be available in Trenton, and which Axson agreed to accept instead of the first truck.

The third was a van which Axson also purchased from Zoltan.

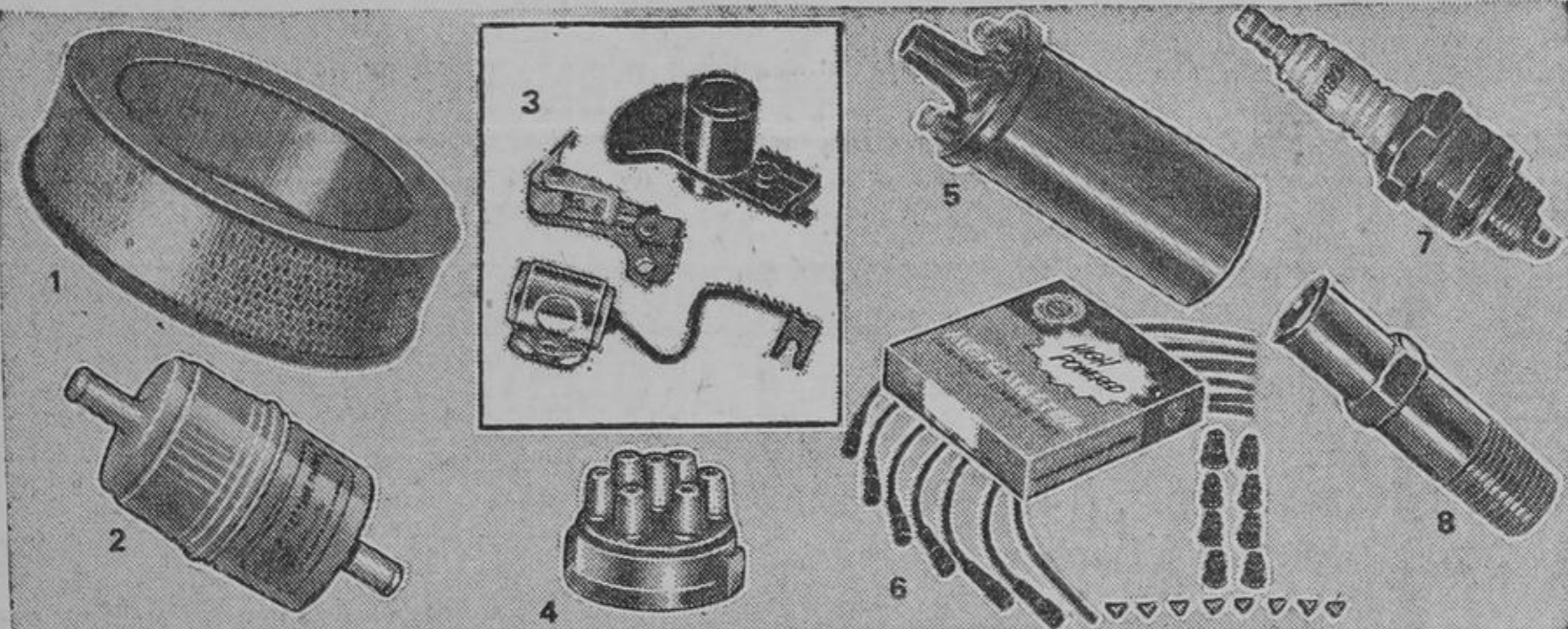

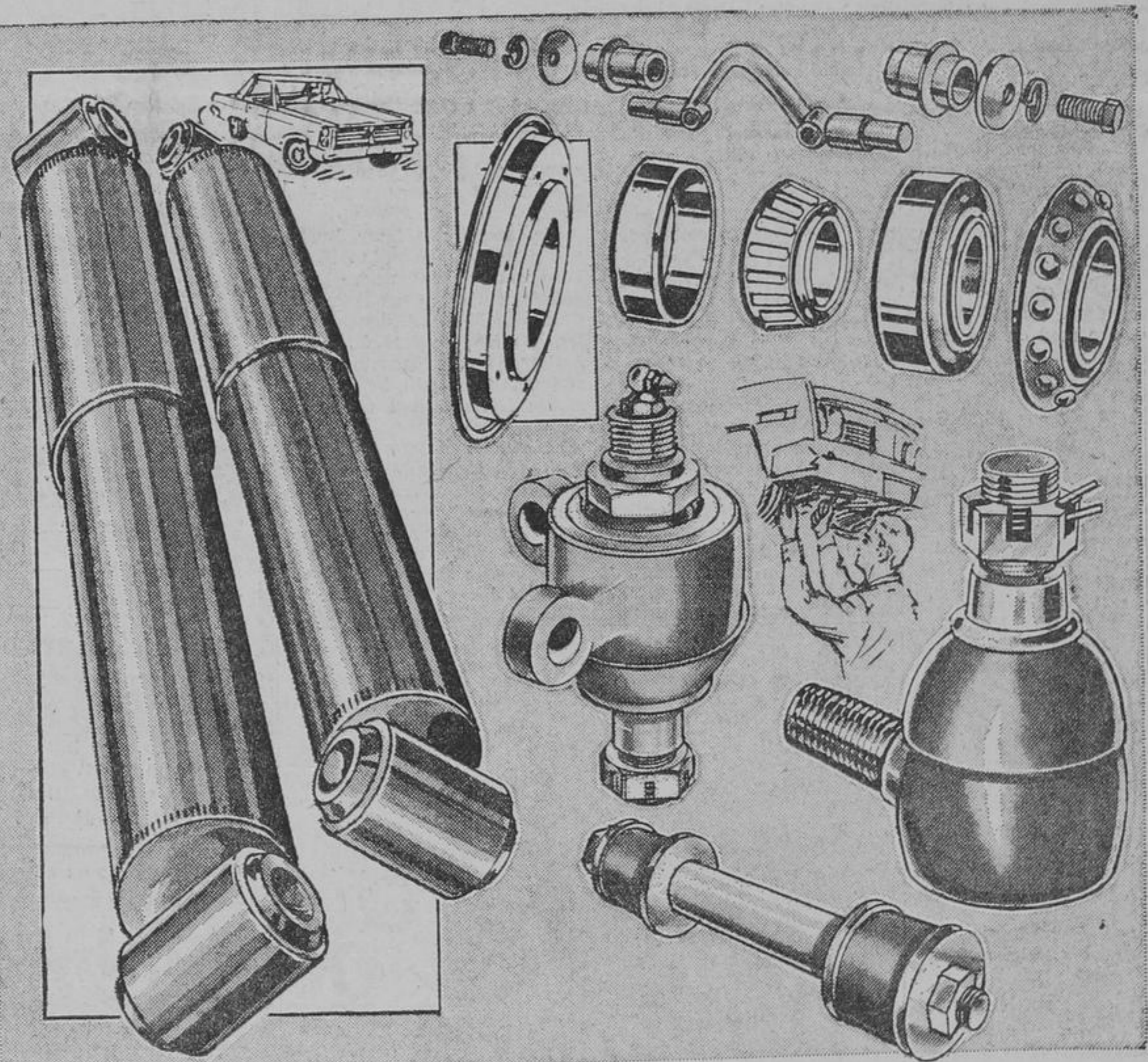

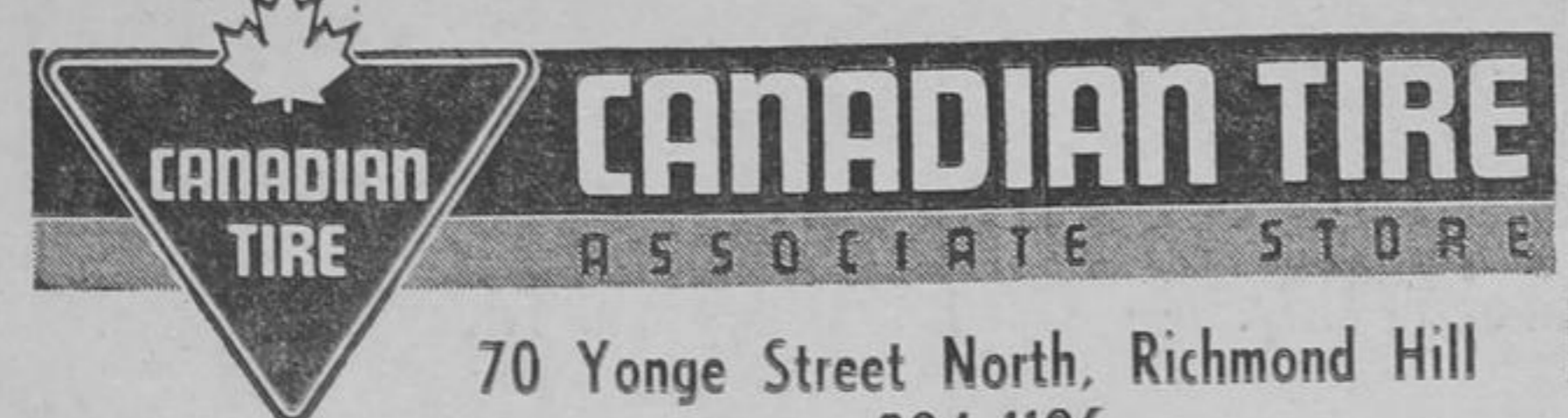
