## Icy Roads Take Heavy Accident Toll

# Blood Loss Kills Jehovah's Witness

An inquest is expected to determine whether family membership in the Jehovah's Witnesses had anything to do with the blood loss death last week of a Keswick youth. He was in a Whitchurch Township road crash.

The Jehovah's Witnesses are a religious group known to oppose administration of blood transfusions to members. Whitchurch Township Police are investigating. A Metro medical official, Coroner Kenneth Baxter, informed the department the youth's death was due to massive hemorrhaging of the pulmonary vein.

Wayne Thomson, 17, of RR 1, Keswick died at 2 am November 28 at Toronto General Hospital after being transferred there from York County Hospital in Newmarket.

He and four other youths were injured at about 9:30 pm the night before when their eastbound car hit a bridge abutment at high speed. The accident was on the Vivian Side-road, west of Concession 5, about four miles east of Newmarket.

Police said passenger Thomson suffered a broken neck, head and internal injuries. A coroner in York County will have to be named to deal with this case, police said.

Driver of the car was Blake Layton, 18, of RR 1, Keswick. He suffered lacerations to the face and leg.

Dean Hansler, 18, of RR 3, Newmarket, was still in York County Hospital at press time. He is being treated for concussion and lacerations.

Ray Hill, 17, of Aurora, was released from hospital after treatment for lacerations and back injuries.

Steve Johnson, 19, of Aurora, was also still in York County Hospital at last report. He is being treated for a broken nose and face lacerations.

The full-sized 1967 model car in which five youths were riding was considered by police to be a complete write-off. The accident is being investigated by Whitchurch Township police Constable David Knowles.

Witnesses said the fatal car came over a hill about 55 to 60 mph. Brakes were applied because of a slow turning or a stopped vehicle ahead. The car went into a skid and hit the bridge.

The first icy roads of the winter season resulted in quite a few bad accidents last week. Richmond Hill drivers had a bad time of it, especially on Bayview Avenue in Markham Township.

A young woman driver from Aurora had a miraculous escape November 26 when her small 1969 model southbound car rolled several times and was a complete write-off.

Miss Carol McCulloch, 20, of 48 Glass Drive, was released from York County Hospital in Newmarket four hours after the accident without even a bandage. This was despite the fact she had a broken back. The broken vertebrae was encased in her rib cage and will heal itself.

Miss McCulloch returned to work four days later. The accident happened when her car went out of control on an icy spot about ¼-mile south of the Gormley Sideroad at 8 a.m. After rolling over and over it came to rest against a fence.

Another car, this one from Richmond Hill, was a complete \$1,500 write-off on the morning of November 26 on Markham Township's icy roads.

Driver Herman Pleschberger, 36 of 333 Gells Road, lost control. His careening 1968 model full-sized car took out four guardrails and rolled down a 40-foot embankment.

He escaped with only a sore back, Markham Township Police said. The accident was at 7:35 am on Concession 5, about ¼-mile north of 14th Avenue.

Tina Anderson of 48 Colon-say Road, Thornhill, suffered glass cuts on the forehead in a bad two-car collision at 9:15 pm November 26 on Bayview Avenue, about 250 yards north of Laureleaf Road.

Police estimated damage was \$1,000 to a car driven by George Anderson, 49, of Colon-say Road.

Damage of about \$600 was suffered by the other vehicle driven by Roger Bertrand, 29, of 3 Cannes Avenue, Dollard des Ormeaux, Quebec.

Three people were injured in another serious two-car collision November 27 in Thornhill. All were treated at York Central Hospital emergency department and released.

Driver Adelaide Velen of 82 Romfield Circuit, Thornhill, had neck and back injuries, plus an estimated 1,000 damage to her car, according to Markham Township Police.

Driver Eva Biro, 19, of 49 Glen Park Avenue, Toronto, had face cuts and about \$800 damage. Her passenger, Christian Biro, 19, had a cut forehead and a back injury.

The accident was at about 7:15 pm on Bayview Avenue, ¼-mile south of Royal Orchard Boulevard.

Bayview Avenue's icy pavement at 7:15 am Nov. 26 was blamed for a Richmond Hill car going out of control while braking. It flipped over in the ditch.

Driver David Barkovic, 29, of 28 Cartier Crescent, escaped injury but had about \$700 damage to his car. Passenger Aimee Barkovic was injured.

The accident happened about 1½ miles north of Highway 7.

In Vaughan Township November 28 a car went out of control and ended standing up at right angles to a telephone pole. Police estimated damage at about \$800, but driver Lauca Smutukich of Rushton Road, Toronto, escaped injury. He was driving south on Bathurst Street, just north of Crestwood Road, Richvale.

His vehicle slid from the west shoulder to the east shoulder, and into the ditch. It hit a guy wire and ran straight up the pole.

A chain reaction accident November 23 at 8:50 am on Bayview Avenue damaged three local cars but nobody was hurt. The rear car in the line was driven by James Docherty, 21 of 162 Markham Road, Richmond Hill. It had an estimated \$250 damage. Markham Township Police said.

There was about \$400 damage to the middle car driven by Charles Fecteau, 52, of 388 Lynett Crescent, Richmond Hill. The front car was driven by Anne Simmonds of Briar Hill Stables, CFB Sideroad, Oak Ridges. It had about \$150 damage.

Elgin Mills Road there was considerable vehicle damage, but no injuries.

A vehicle driven by Brenda Laing of Cocksfield Street, Downsview, had an estimated \$500 damage. Vaughan Township Police said.

The other vehicle was driven by Nick Ferlito of St. Clarens Avenue, Toronto, and had about \$200 damage.

Arthur Taylor, 43, of 69 Lady-slipper Court, Thornhill had an estimated \$100 damage to his car November 26.

He was in a collision at 8:30 am at Henderson Street and Clark Avenue, South Thornhill. The other driver, David Al-twaters, 19, of 96 Grandview Avenue, Thornhill, had damage estimated at \$75. Markham Township Police said.

Buttonville driver Doreen Kirkpatrick of 32 Hughson Drive, had an estimated \$150 damage November 20.

She was in a two-car collision on Woodbine Avenue, ¾-mile north of Highway 7.

There was about \$75 damage to the other car driven by Andrew White, 22, of Orillia.

John Venge of Fonthill Boulevard, Unionville, lost control of his vehicle November 29 on Maple Sideroad in Vaughan Township.

He skidded off the roadway and hit several roadside posts. Damage was estimated at only \$100. Vaughan Township Police said.
