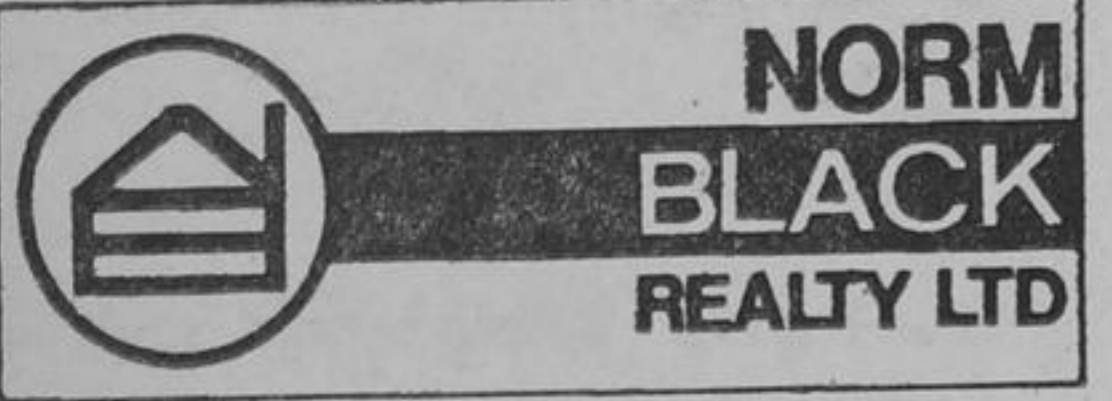

Tip To Snow Shoveller: Throw Snow To Right

That time of year is here again! The time of back-breaking struggle to clear one's driveway and walks of snow, and the time of the heartbreak of seeing your work undone as the highway snowplows pass down the street and deposit a two-foot high snow barrier across the nicely cleared entranceway. "The Liberal" has already this year received several complaints of this nature.

This happens in every community — at least in every municipality where an effort is made to keep the roads clear of snow and traffic moving freely. We have learned from men experienced in snow clearing work that the annoyance can be alleviated to a great degree if in clearing your driveway you throw all snow removed to the right (when you are facing the road). Then on the left side of the entrance angle the snow back to provide a spot into which the load scraped up by the plow's wing in front of your neighbor's property may be dumped.

There are two other solutions — one expensive and one impractical in built-up areas. The first is the addition of a special gate to the wing which prevents the snow being dumped in driveway entrances and the other is the lifting of the wing at each entrance way.
