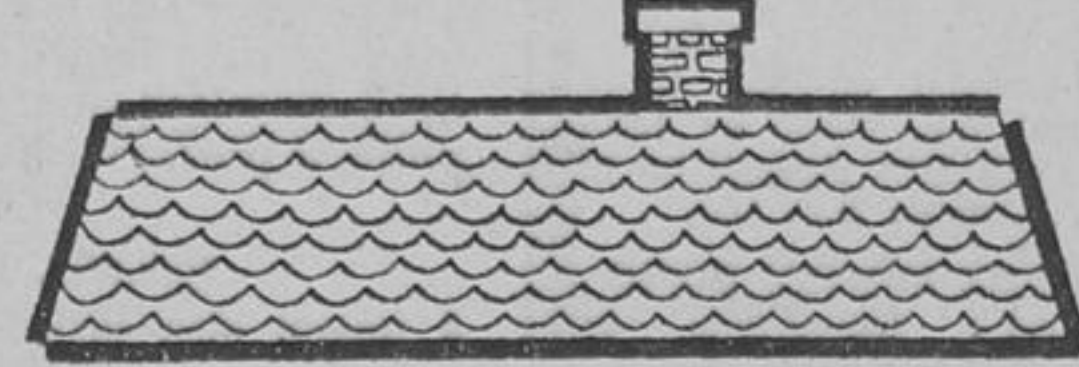

Markham Town is planning on placing a 25-mile-per-hour speed limit on all roads in its built up areas. Putting up some opposition to this is Councillor Jim Jongseneel who is not so sure that a straight across-the-board 25 miles should prevail in all areas of built-up sections.

"I think it should apply in some areas and not in others," he said. "I think 30 miles-per-hour is more appropriate in some places. In any case I would like to hear the opinions of residents in the built-up areas before making up my mind."
