## Blaze Destroys Barn In Vaughan, Tank Donated For Water Truck

Fires in Vaughan Town last week destroyed a barn, damaged a house under construction, and damaged several cars. In Richmond Hill firefighters and children were blamed for a fire that destroyed a chicken house. A goose got its wings singed.

Vaughan Fire Department has been donated a 1,500 gallon insulated stainless steel truck tank, for water carrying purposes in rural areas.

This will be mounted on a used truck chassis just purchased over by Richmond Hill January 1 when an area of Vaughan was annexed.

The tank was donated by Hugh Strachan, formerly of Woodbridge, who has moved his milk transport business to the Woodstock area.

The barn fire was reported at 5:24 pm May 9 on Lot 33, Concession 4 (Keele Street). Damage was estimated at \$1,500. Cause of the fire isn't known and the building was empty.

Owner is Murray Krigston of 80 Westgate Boulevard, Toronto.

A workman's cigarette butt thrown into straw in the basement of a house under construction in Thornhill was blamed for a fire Monday at 8:59 am at 52 Forest Park Crescent.

Damage was about \$200. Vaughan Fire Chief James Davidson said.

The property is owned by Lonjo Construction Company Limited, 9 Vanwood Road, Thornhill.

## Blaze Destroys Barn In Vaughan, Tank Donated For Water Truck

Damage was about \$300 in a fire in a 1962 Volkswagen car opposite 8200 Keele Street at 11:04 am May 7.

The fire started in the car's motor. The owner was Otto Cestnick of 27 Barlowe Street, Scarborough.

A house trailer fire was reported at 3:27 am May 8 at Lot 31, Keele Street.

Damage was \$150 to the unoccupied trailer, owned by Vincent Aloio of Toronto.

Cause of the fire is being investigated.

Another house under construction in Thornhill last week was threatened by fire when children playing in the basement started a blaze in some paper and straw.

But the house owned by Snow - Shields Construction Company at 24 Hester Court was saved from damage.

The fire alarm was at 8:15 pm May 6.

A glass jar sitting in the back seat of a car was blamed for a \$100 fire at 4:58 pm May 4 on Jane Street south of the King-Vaughan line.

Vaughan Firemen believe this was one of those rare cases where a curved glass focussed sunlight to a hot enough temperature to start the back seat on fire.

The car was owned by Innocente Valentino, 274 Harvey Avenue, Toronto.

Fire destroyed a shed considered to be of negligible value in Vaughan at 9:18 am April 27.

The fire was on the property of Chefero Sand and Gravel Limited, Lot 27, Concession 3, Vaughan.

## Blaze Destroys Barn In Vaughan, Tank Donated For Water Truck

The Vaughan Fire Department used portable power equipment to push apart a squashed automobile after a fatal accident on Highway 7 east of Bayview Avenue at 3:10 am April 29.

Two people were freed from the wreck and removed on fire department stretchers.
