

### Tape Players Recovered Add Three Months To Thief's Prior Sentence

A 21-year-old convicted recently on a drug trafficking charge was back in Richmond Hill court Thursday of last week admitting to being a perpetrator in the last winter's small plague of car tape player thefts.

Michael Lynn of 160 Essex Avenue, Apartment 312, Richmond Hill, was already serving a sentence of nine months definite and six months indeterminate on a narcotics conviction. He pleaded guilty to four tape deck theft charges. Four other criminal charges were withdrawn by the Crown.

Provincial Judge Charles Opper noted it was the young married man's first conviction under the Criminal Code and

gave him an additional three-month sentence on each conviction. The four sentences are to run concurrently to the other, but consecutive to the drug trafficking sentence.

Crown Attorney William Donaldson told the court the four stolen players were valued at about \$500 and were all recovered from parked cars in driveways. Bruce Thompson of 164 Parkston Court had his player stolen the night of October 13-14. Eric Radke had his tape deck stolen between October 31 and November 2. Douglas Dempster of 163 Elmwood Avenue had his tape player stolen on the night of November 1-2 and Dennis Shannon of 402 Markham Road had his player stolen November 20.

Brian Copplestone, 19, of Bayview Avenue, Lake Wilcox, pleaded guilty to driving without due care and attention in a crash on the Langstaff Side-road.

A married man with a four-month-old child, he was fined \$150 or 15 days and given three weeks to pay. Crown Attorney Donaldson withdrew a dangerous driving charge.

Copplestone's Attorney Alfred Stong of Richmond Hill told the court his client was coming home from the night shift at the
