Notice is hereby given to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, RSO 1960, Chapter 427, 1965, 141 amended, that unless noxious weeds growing on their lands within the municipality of The Town of Richmond Hill, are destroyed by date of June 10, 1972, with necessary cuttings throughout the season, the municipality may enter upon the said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging the costs against the lands in taxes, as set out in the Act.

The compliance with the terms of this act by all citizens is mandatory.






