Three Weeks In Bush After 'Copter Crash

Three weeks after his helicopter went down on the Ungava Peninsula of Northern Quebec, Lynn McKay, 27, of Newmarket was found alive and well last week.

His helicopter, owned by Dominion Helicopters Ltd., of King City, apparently ran out of fuel after he became lost on a flight from Povungnituk on Hudson Bay to an asbestos mine 250 miles east of there.

An intensive search for the pilot had ended Monday and on Tuesday his helicopter was spotted beside a cabin on the Payne River, about 130 miles off his course, by a pilot from St. Felicien Airways of Fort Chimo, on a routine flight. The pilot landed his float plane on the river and rescued McKay.

According to a search official there was some food in the cabin and Mr. McKay had some on the helicopter.
