## Bomb Scare At Schomberg Arena

Everything from a bomb threat to purse snatching were reported by York Regional Police in a series of unusual incidents in the area last week.

In Schomberg, Frank McArthur of the Schomberg Arena, Main Street, told police that a male caller had phoned the rink November 19 at 7:35 pm and was quoted as saying: "You have till midnight to clear the arena, as there is a bomb planted there."

Investigation by police showed there was no bomb on the premises.

Mrs. Marjorie Mitchell, 248 Bluegrass Boulevard, Richmond Hill, had her purse taken from her while she was putting groceries into her car in front of the Dominion Store in the Richvale area.

Mrs. Mitchell said that she had been approached by a youth asking to use a lighter. When she bent down, he grabbed her purse and ran.

Credit cards and about \$25 in cash were in the purse.

A Richmond Hill man has been charged with wounding and with the dangerous use of firearms, following an incident November 18.

Alexander Beauchamp, 755 Steeles Avenue West, Willowdale, told police he and two women had been drinking at the home of Robert McCormack, 22 of 60 Laverock Road, when an argument developed.

He said a gun was produced and in the ensuing struggle, it discharged, sending a bullet through his left hand.
