

Vaughan Husband Learns

**You Can't Put Out Your Wife
And Fire Rifle Over Her Head**

You can't put your wife out of the house and fire a gun over her head to scare her away, even if she does dump a bucket of water over your head, according to Provincial Judge Russell Pearse in Richmond Hill Court November 9.

Judge Pearse convicted a Pine Grove, Vaughan Town man on the July charge of using a 22-calibre rifle in a manner dangerous to the safety of others. The wife, now living alone, told the court she was sorry.

Defense Attorney Dave Hobson of the Richmond Hill law firm of Lawlor, Leclaire, Stong and Nevins requested the husband be given a conditional discharge and allowed to go free without a criminal conviction after behaving himself during a period of probation.

"He fired out of frustration and shot over her head. I suggest they both have bad tempers," said Hobson, noting the couple had been married seven years.

But Judge Pearse disagreed. "I don't think a conditional discharge should be considered where there is violence of this kind. He lost his temper and fired a gun. Somebody could be hurt. By granting a discharge in this case I would be setting a precedent that anyone using a gun would be entitled to go free."

He gave the husband a suspended sentence, and two years probation, ordering him to keep away from all sorts of guns and other weapons, and to keep the peace.

CROWN AGREEABLE
Assistant Crown Attorney John Kerr said he wasn't opposed to the conditional discharge request if the husband was ordered to abstain from drinking alcoholic beverages. "Alcohol appears to be at the root of this domestic dispute," he told the court.

The husband pleaded guilty. They were having a dispute in the kitchen when she threw the water on him. He got the gun and made threats. He fired the rifle but didn't hit her, after locking her outside the door and telling her to go. The bullet went through the upper part of the glass in the door while the wife was below on the porch stairs, the court

was told.
WIFE NOT AFRAID
The wife was in court and confirmed she hadn't been afraid of really being hurt. She went back and broke the rest of the glass out of the window, but cut herself. She called her 12-year-old son and went to the neighbors to call police to teach her husband a lesson. They'd both been drinking.

The couple lived together for a month after the incident, then agreed to an amicable legal separation. "I don't want to see him charged. I aggravated him," the wife told Judge Pearse.

**5 Regional Mayors
Are Acclaimed**

The majority of mayors in the nine municipalities which make up the Region of York have been elected by acclamation.

Mayor Garnet Williams of Vaughan, Mayor Anthony Roman of Markham, Mayor Dick Illingworth of Aurora and Mayor Bob Forhan of Newmarket have all been re-elected to head their municipal councils and by virtue of their office to sit on regional council. The new mayor of Whitechurch-Stouffville (replacing Ken Laushway who is retiring) is Gordon Ratcliff who also was acclaimed. Newmarket's Regional Councillor Ray Twiney also was returned for a second term by acclamation.

In Richmond Hill incumbent Mayor William Lazenby who has served in that office for three years following a six-year stint on council, is being challenged by David Schiller who has sat on council for the past three years.

In King Township a four-way contest for the mayor's chair is underway. Mayor Ken Mactaggart is retiring and entered in the lists to decide his successor are Margaret Britnell, former councillor, Donald Findlay and Roy Wilson, present councillors; and Ted Rowe, who managed MP Sinclair Stevens' successful federal campaign in York Simcoe Riding.

East Gwillimbury's Mayor Gladys Rolling is having competition this year from Lindsay Farr, a long-time township employee.

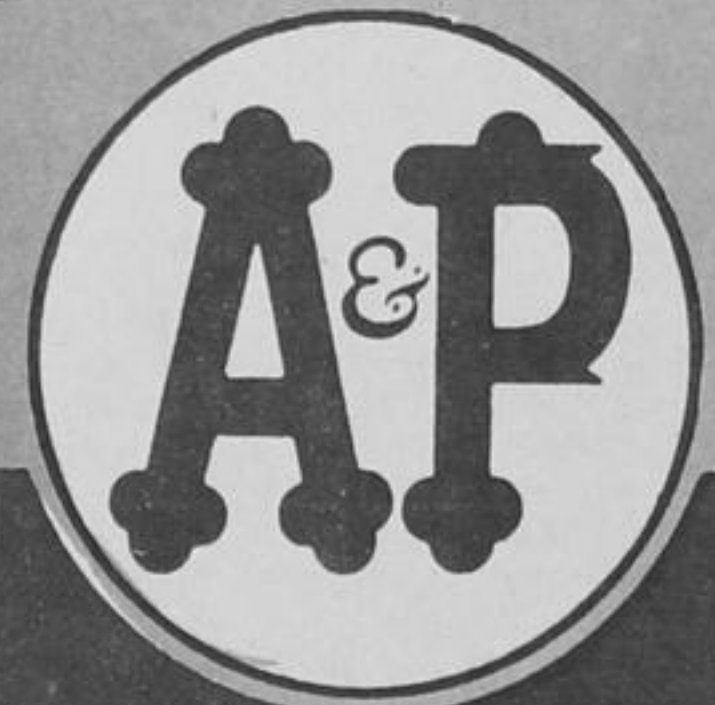
