

Rev. Herbert Newton - Smith Served Church Half A Century

A man with a great sense of humor and a beautiful faith, describes the late Rev. Herbert Newton-Smith, who died in York Central Hospital early Sunday morning. Although Mr. Newton-Smith

retired from the ministry in 1963 after a half century of service in many parishes of the Anglican Church he continued to be active in the service of his Lord and Master as Honorary Assistant at

the Church of St. Gabriel The Archangel, Bayview and Crosby Avenues, Richmond Hill.

Born in Yorkshire, England, October 3, 1886, Mr. Newton-Smith came to Can-

ada in his early teens and finished his secondary schooling in Toronto. Since money was scarce in those days he worked to put himself through university and was ordained a full year be-

fore graduating from Wycliffe College in 1913.

He was given his first parish in the Niagara Diocese which was composed of three churches and two Sunday schools, spread over a distance of 29 miles, which he covered on Sunday by horse and buggy, returning to his studies at Wycliffe Monday morning.

He subsequently served in many parishes in the Niag-

ara district, including Hagersville, Chippewa Trinity (where he built the parish hall), Grace Church in Arthur (which he rebuilt after a disastrous fire), and at St. Margaret's in West Hamilton.

Recently Mr. Newton-Smith penned these few lines:

When I pass on
I shall not look for streets
of gold
Or gates of pearl

But for a row of northern maples
Glistening in their scarlet robes
Against a background of a windy Canadian sky.
He was closely associated with the Canadian National Institute Of The Blind and each summer attended the camp for the blind near Parry Sound. An avid fan of the Hamilton Tiger Cats, he also had a particular attachment for Russ Jackson, whom he had taught in Sunday school.
Surviving to mourn the passing of a beloved father are Rev. Jack Newton-Smith of Lindsay, the first rector of St. Gabriel's; Iris (Mrs. Lawrence Boustead) of North Taylor Mills Drive, Richmond Hill; Ruth (Mrs. Vic Oke) of Hamilton and Marjorie Newton-Smith of Severn Bridge.
He was predeceased by his wife December 6 a decade ago and Mr. Newton-Smith had had placed in the sanctuary of St. Gabriel's on Sunday flowers in her memory which featured her favorite red roses.
The funeral service was held at St. Gabriel's Wednesday morning at 11 am, followed by interment at St. George's, Hannon, near Hamilton.
