3 Young Men Are Determined To Smoke Illegal Marijuana

It was the law versus three young men determined to smoke marijuana whenever they liked. "It hasn't been legalized. It may never be legalized. The sentence should deter him," Federal Prosecutor Steve Sheriff told Provincial Judge Russell Pearce in Richmond Hill Court Thursday of last week.

Sheriff said he realized the use of marijuana is really an attitude which the jail isn't going to change. He noted the previous June 19 conviction and \$75 fine of Malcolm Conyers, 19, of 36 Woodbridge Avenue, Vaughan, didn't deter Conyers from having the illegal drug and hadn't stopped a continuous pattern of use.

ALL USE DRUGS
Conyers and two other accused youths all indicated in court that they indulge in marijuana when they like and most of their friends do too. But the other two, Joseph Gabrielle of Jane Street, Downsview, and Bryan Wood of 172 Lindylou Road, Weston, were found innocent.

ADMITS RECORD
Gabrielle admitted a considerable criminal record including break-in and theft, common assault and theft, but no previous drug convictions.

Both Gabrielle and Wood took the witness stand and swore they didn't have the marijuana and didn't know there was any in the truck that night. Conyers elected not to testify and didn't deny anything. "I was in the Woodbridge Hotel drinking for some time that day. I went to sleep in the back of the truck and woke up in custody. I smoke marijuana. So does Joe Gabrielle," Wood told the court. "I do smoke... have for quite a while. I didn't know there was any in the truck that night. I didn't see anyone throw anything out... Conyers smokes marijuana, most of my friends do," testified Gabrielle.

MUST OBEY LAW
Judge Pearce said the law is made by the Parliament of Canada and he was on the bench to see the law was obeyed.

"If he (Conyers) doesn't correct his ways, he's going to end up in jail, no doubt about that," said Judge Pearce. He gave Conyers a \$150 fine or 60 days in jail, with until February 2 to pay. The youth also agreed to spend a year on probation under the supervision of a probation officer. He also

Collingwood Man Committed To Trial In Vaughan Knife Robbery

A young Collingwood man Thursday of last week in Richmond Hill Court was committed for trial in York County Court for the knife robbery of a Vaughan Town gas bar August 19.

Provincial Judge Russell Pearce granted a defense request that evidence at the preliminary hearing not be published until after the trial. A separate hearing was held for Gardner because his co-accused Charles Branget of Stayner was in hospital. Gardner and Branget were arrested and charged after

Walker's Gas Bar was reported robbed of a sum of money late at night. Reginald Arch, 48, of 53 Benson Avenue, Richmond Hill was fined \$175 or 30 days for refusing a breathalyzer test October 17 in Richmond Hill. His license was also suspended for three months due to the conviction. Police found Arch sitting in a car in the parking lot of the Burger Bar on Yonge Street in Oak Ridges at 10:35 pm, Crown Attorney John Kerr told the court.

Arch subsequently refused to take the breath test at the OPP Detachment in Oak Ridges. Defense Attorney Donald Plaxton told the Court Arch pulled off the road to sober up and didn't think he should have to take the test. Byral Bryan, 30, of 114 Henderson Avenue, South Thornhill was also fined \$175 or 30 days jail for driving while impaired December 10 in Richmond Hill. He was driving in an erratic manner south on Yonge Street from Markham Road at 1 am and had a breathalyzer test reading of 2.60, the court was told. His license to drive was also automatically suspended three months. Allan Hollis, 18, of 71 Pemberton Crescent, Richmond Hill, was fined \$20 or four days jail for being intoxicated in a public place. He was arrested New Year's Day in the CN Administration Building at Concord, the court was told.
