## Water Sewage Roads Cable 10 Thursday

By the year 1980 the southern part of York Region will be wholly dependent on an extension of Metro Toronto's trunk system for essential services. This is the conclusion reached by Regional Planning and Engineering Commissioners Murray Pound and Bob Hodgson in the second program of "The York Region - Planning and You" being aired Thursday evenings on TV 10 (cable).

The need for improvement in water supply and sewage disposal systems is reaching a critical point with the current boom in development, the guests agree. What price Metro hookup?

Do you believe that traffic pressures on Yonge Street should be relieved by developing Bathurst and Bayview as major arteries? Are you disappointed in the recent choice of roads for improvement? Are you aware of how and under whose control a traffic needs study is conducted and just how precisely traffic pat-

terns can be predicted? If these questions concern you - and they should tune in to TV 10 Thursday night at 7 pm. The program will be repeated at the top of each hour until midnight. NEWMARKET: A bylaw callfor the installation of sprinkler systems in new homes, business and industrial buildings has been given approval by council for the second time. The bylaw was approved earlier this year but has been revised.
