Youths Sent To Trial On Drug Traffic Charges

Two young men arrested by local police on drug trafficking charges pleaded innocent in the November drug session at Newmarket Provincial Court and were committed for trial in County Court.

Two others denied trafficking charges. They were allowed by Federal Prosecutor Eric deBecker to plead guilty to lesser charges, then were convicted and punished.
