## Alex Sutherland Escapes Serious Hurt

Alexander Sutherland of 268 Gretel Drive, Richmond Hill, is thanking his lucky stars this week. Saturday he was driving an Imperial Oil Ltd. tank truck and pup trailer containing 13,000 gallons of gasoline along Highway 115 to make deliveries in the Peterboro area.

Strong gusts of wind apparently swerved the pup trailer, tipping it. The cab and main trailer continued on for nearly 1,000 feet, dragging the pup trailer along on its side, spewing flaming gasoline.

Driver Sutherland stopped the truck and fled unhurt on foot just ahead of the flames which spread to the main trailer and cab.

Four fire departments could do little to control the blaze which burned for four hours. The highway was blocked for about 10 hours in all and traffic was rerouted to nearby roads. Site of the accident was about 12 miles south of Peterboro.

# Police Acted Properly, United Church Arrest

Getting to the church on time has resulted in some unexpected aggravation for York Regional Police Chief Bruce Crawford.

This was the case Thursday night of last week when members of the police commission heard a report from Chief Crawford regarding a complaint made by Trinity United Church Minister Bruce Sutor.

His complaint resulted from the arrest of Wayne Taylor, 21, and Arthur Burgin, 23, both of Willowdale, just outside the church after they had both been married in a double wedding ceremony.

Mr. Sutor had objected to the fact three plain clothesmen entered the church during a religious ceremony, sat there while the ceremony was going on and then apprehended the principals outside the church afterwards.

He was also unhappy about his alleged treatment at the police station telling Commissioner Ray Twinney that he had wanted to see the chief but had been told he was too busy to see him.

Chief Crawford told the commission that warrants had been out for the two men for break and enter in Richmond Hill and that the police had been informed the two wanted men would be getting married in the church.

The police took up observation around the church and one plain clothesman entered to see if the wanted men were at the church. A little later two other detectives entered a side door of the church, talked to church officials, and then left to await the bridegrooms outside.

"When they exited from the church four detectives arrested them with quiet dignity," said Chief Crawford, "and took them to the police station. The men were arrested outside the church and all the police were in plain clothes."

Chief Crawford agreed that Mr. Sutor had later attended the station and requested to see him but "at that time I was unable to see him. I wasn't even aware of the nature of the matter at that time."

He said that Sutor had not left any request to have him call him at a later date "or I would have been very pleased to do so."

Mr. Sutor was later interviewed by Deputy Chief Wally Harkness and at that time he "seemed to be satisfied with this interview. He did not request me to call him on this occasion either."

"I am satisfied the arrests were carried out in a perfectly legal and dignified manner with no criticism to be directed at the officers concerned."

Commissioner Twinney suggested he would talk to Mr. Sutor and ascertain if he had any further comments to make regarding the situation.

Chief Crawford observed that if Mr. Sutor had any further complaints "he should come before the commission" and didn't feel it would be fair to ask him to possibly get another report from the result of what Commissioner Twinney would bring back at the next meeting.

Mr. Twinney said he thought it was his job as a commissioner to bring any complaint to the board and to talk to Mr. Sutor.

"I can't say whether what has been said is right or wrong because I don't know the answers. That's why I want to talk to Mr. Sutor."

Commissioner Gordon Cook objected to any implied criticism of the chief's report as well as to the method of arrest.

"I have the greatest respect for the police regardless of where the arrest was made. I feel the detectives did an excellent job. If a warrant is out for the arrest of someone they should be arrested regardless of where they are or under what circumstances."

Mr. Twinney said he wasn't questioning the right of the police to make the arrest or questioning the result report.

"I just want to find out if it agrees with Mr. Sutor's statements. I admit I erred in not speaking to Mr. Sutor directly instead of getting the story third-hand."

Commission Chairman Judge William Lyon suggested Mr. Twinney talk to Mr. Sutor and bring back his remarks for the next meeting. He added that the board would also be agreeable to having him appear before them in person if he so desired.

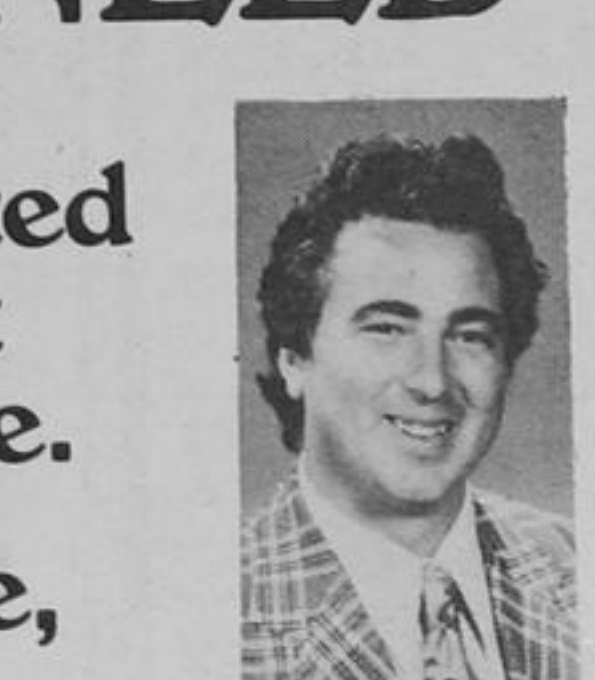
