Ward 3 ratepayers, concerned about the future of Richmond Hill and particularly about the future of their area of this town, formed a steering committee April 22, and will hold an organizational meeting May 14 at 7:30 pm in Walter Scott School, Markham Road.
The main purpose of the organization will be to work for the best interests of the citizens in Ward 3, the area reaching from Highway 7 in the south to Markham Road in the north and from Yonge Street on the west to Leslie Street on the east. At present, this area has no representation on the parks and recreation committee of Richmond Hill. Residents are concerned that if developers have their way, there simply won't be any green spots in Ward 3 and it seems that developers are moving in fast!

Residents also feel that a ratepayers' organization can do a great deal for their area in seeing it remains a pleasant place in which to live. Ward 3 has expanded to encompass the "new" Richmond Hill. That is why it is so important for this new voice of citizens to be heard along with the rest of the town on such matters as the Langstaff Jail Farm's future, zoning plans and other areas of concern.

MAKE IT FRESH!

Although modern methods of production, storage and marketing mean that Canadians can enjoy a wide variety of vegetables and fruits at any time of the year, there is something special about the arrival of Ontario-grown hothouse and garden produce. Ontario-grown produce adds incomparable flavour and colour to every meal.
Did you know that in many fruits and vegetables, the majority of vitamins and minerals are stored just beneath the skin? To get the best food value, prepare vegetables in their 'jackets' or skins when possible. Eat fruit and vegetables raw frequently. Since the vitamins are close to the surface, cook vegetables quickly in a small amount of boiling water, just until barely tender. This will preserve as much of the natural vitamin content of the vegetable as possible. When done, the vegetable should be tender but still have some 'crunch' or bite. Plan meal preparation so that the vegetables will be tender just at the moment the meal is ready to serve.
