#### TO DISPENSE WITH A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

- 1. The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to apply to The Ontario Municipal Board for approval of an additional expenditure of \$100,000 for the construction of a works and maintenance garage on the north side of Miller Avenue, being part of Lot 7, Concession four in the Town of Markham, more particularly shown as parts 1 and 2 on Plan R-4411, which amount shall be raised by sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding twenty (20) years.
- Application will be made to The Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by post prepaid to the clerk of the Town of Markham at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.
- 3. The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.


