E. Canada Trials At Seneca-King June 15-16

Some of Canada's top horses will meet in the Eastern Canadian Championship trials June 15-16 at Seneca College's King Campus, west of Aurora. It's a family outdoors day with babysitting, swimming, boating and free hayrides.

It'll be the first time the college has been host for the Eastern Canadian trials.

The two-day event will include open, intermediate and preliminary divisions in dressage, road-and-track, cross-country and stadium jumping tests.

A total of 82 horses from Quebec and Ontario are entered.

RECORD 30 ENTRIES
Thirty entries have been

received in the open intermediate championship, the largest ever recorded in this category.

The Seneca College Horse Trials begin early Saturday with dressage for preliminary and open intermediate championships. On Sunday morning, the cross-country

competition starts at 8:30 am and is followed by the stadium jumping which commences about 2 pm. The open intermediate classification continues all day Sunday.

TOP RIDERS ENTERED
Some of the top riders entered include: Jim Day, Jim Henry, Liz Ashton, Ian Angus, Allan Ehrlick and Mrs. Hans Renz. Quebec entries include Paul Popiel and Lorraine Laframboise. W. Roy McCutcheon, dean of Seneca's King Campus,

and one of the two co-chairmen of the event says: "The Seneca College Horse Trials are attracting large numbers of horsemen and women from all over Eastern Canada. But we would like to make it clear that everyone is welcome to make a day of it — out with family."

The King Campus is located on Dufferin Street, two miles north of the King City Sideroad. You travel west off Yonge Street at Oak Ridges, or east off Highway 400 at the King exit.

Admission to the horse trials is \$2 for adults, \$1 for children.

New Woodbridge School St. Peter's

New German Mills RC School St. Michael's To Be Relocatable

The relocatable school at West Woodbridge (and the permanent school which will replace it) will be named St. Peter's, York County Roman Catholic School Board decided at its June 4 meeting. The relocatable school and its furnishings have all been ordered and it is expected that the school will be ready in good time for occupancy on September 3, 1974, the first day of the coming school year.

The York County Board of Education has accepted the separate school board's offer of \$348,000 for the school site and approval of this expenditure has been received from the Ministry of Education. The board passed By-law 27 authorizing interim borrowing of this amount.

200 STUDENTS

St. Peter's Woodbridge will accommodate pupils in kindergarten to grade 6 and will be staffed by six teachers, a principal, a half-time kindergarten teacher, a half-time French teacher and a quarter-time librarian. The expected enrolment is in the neighborhood of 200. Mr. Glenn MacAlpine will be the principal.

A letter being distributed to all Catholic parents in the area, in English and in Italian, explains that grades 7 and 8 students will be transported to St. Margaret Mary Catholic School in Pine Grove, which has better facilities for these senior students. It has a science room, a library and a gymnasium.

The letter also explains that St. Peter's and St. Margaret Mary School will have extra help for children who cannot speak English very well.

Registrations for next school year at St. Peter's may be made at St. Margaret Mary during this month and at the new school during the last week in August.

GERMAN MILLS
A similar letter will also go out to parents in the German Mills area, where another relocatable school will contain four classrooms plus a kindergarten (half day) and a principal. This school (and the permanent structure which will replace it) will be called St. Michael's.

Ministerial approval for this school has just been received, the order is in both for the temporary building and the furniture, it was reported.

TO DISPENSE WITH A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

- The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to apply to The Ontario Municipal Board for approval of an additional expenditure of \$100,000 for the construction of a works and maintenance garage on the north side of Miller Avenue, being part of Lot 7, Concession four in the Town of Markham, more particularly shown as parts 1 and 2 on Plan R-4411, which amount shall be raised by sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding twenty (20) years.
- Application will be made to The Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by post prepaid to the clerk of the Town of Markham at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.
- The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.
