YRP Constable Tried And Tried And Tried

The story of how a York Regional Police constable made some routine checks at 1 am at a Richmond Hill tavern and ended up arresting three drunken youths, was recounted in Richmond Hill Court before Provincial Judge Russell Pearce July 12.

Constable Ivars Vitins told how he walked through the Richmond Inn at 1:02 am and found William Cox of 170 Dudley Avenue, Thornhill in a staggering, swaying, incoherent condition with eyes glassy and sleepy. He arrested Cox for being intoxicated in a public place.

Then Constable Vitins went back to try to finish his check of the tavern at 1:11 am. In the downstairs beverage room he found a man holding onto the tables and staggering in a drunken condition. So he arrested Leonard Allan, 21, of 60 Birch Avenue, Richvale for being intoxicated in a public place.

Back again to try and finish his tavern check at 1:15 am the YRP constable came upon Stephen Parker of 400 South Fernleigh Circle, Richmond Hill in the hallway, staggering and leaning on the wall. So he made another intoxication arrest. He didn't tell the court whether or not he tried to finish his tavern check again.

Called to court to face the charge, none of the three men attended. Judge Pearce entered innocent pleas on the record for each, heard the constable's evidence, and convicted them.

Each of the three was fined \$13 or three days in Don Jail.

\$100,000 Fire Damage Eaton Home, Aurora North

Damage estimated at \$100,000 was done to the contents and home of Mr. and Mrs. Timothy Eaton, at Tara Hill, Yonge Street, just north of Aurora, in the early morning hours of July 10.

The fire was discovered by Mrs. Georgina Eaton, who was awakened by smoke and by the sound of what seemed like dishes breaking. She and a housekeeper were the only ones in the house at the time.

Mrs. Eaton ran outside the house and flagged down a passing motorist, Ronald Vanderveek, of Spruce Street, Aurora, who turned in the alarm.

The Aurora Fire Department responded and stayed at the scene for nearly three hours.

Cause of the fire, which was confined to the sunroom and kitchen, is unknown.

Aurora Fire Chief Gordon Burling said the damage was originally estimated at \$30,000, but subsequent insurance company estimates had come up with the \$100,000 figure, with \$75,000 to the house and \$25,000 to the contents.

Mr. Eaton, who has been residing in England, is a grandson of Timothy Eaton, founder of the T. Eaton Company.

In Vaughan, a radio which was left playing after everyone had gone, was blamed for a fire at Builders Tool Supplies Limited, Snidercroft Road, Concord.

The fire from the overheated radio set off the sprinkler system in the building, which helped to subdue some of the blaze by the time the Vaughan Fire Department arrived.

Damage was estimated at \$600.

THE EXPROPRIATIONS ACT NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND

IN THE MATTER of an application by the Minister of Transportation and Communications for approval to expropriate lands being in the Town of Markham, in the Town of Vaughan and in the Town of Richmond Hill, in the Regional Municipality of York, in the Province of Ontario, for the purpose of acquiring sufficient land to accommodate the reconstruction of the King's Highway 11 and portions of certain intersecting roads in connection therewith.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described in the schedule hereto. Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

- in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served with the notice, or when he is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;
- in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

THE APPROVING AUTHORITY IS Minister of Transportation and Communications Parliament Buildings Toronto, Ontario. M7A 1Z8
Minister of Transportation and Communications W. G. Wible Director, Right-of-Way Branch.

NOTES:

- The Expropriations Act provides that,
 - where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Minister of Justice and Attorney General;
 - the inquiry officer,
 - shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and
 - may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.
- "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows: "owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested; "registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper Land Registry or Sheriff's Office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll;
- The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.
