Owners and President Edward Green and Mrs. Green of the parent firm Newman-Green Incorporated of Addison, Illinois, along with members of their family were welcomed here for the event by Canadian

General Manager Kirk Payne. He is a native of the Swift Current area in Saskatchewan and 30-year Ontario resident.

FIRST IN CANADA
Newman-Green was Canada's first aerosol valve manufacturer and was established here in 1965 at 301 Markham Road. The firm's

arrival here appears likely to be the first step in making Richmond Hill the aerosol valve centre of Canada as Newman Green expands and other companies follow them into the area.

Newman-Green moved in February from its founding and smaller facility at Markham Road to the new building which stands on two acres of land with lots of room for expansion. General Manager Payne says expansion plans are already in the thinking stages as

operations show a continuous steady growth.
