## CRUETS AND THE PICKLE PATCH

In frontier days, the "pickle patch" was an important part of every home garden, providing tasty and nutritious complements to almost every meal through the long winter months. And the pioneer homemaker honored the pickle by serving the fruits of her labors in elaborate containers, cruets of many interesting shapes, colors and designs. From August 15 to October the Gibson House Museum has on display a selection of 30 cruets especially lighted to show the delicate patterns and beautiful colored glass. The collection, mainly of cranberry, primrose, amber, emerald green and amethyst colors, has several pieces for contrast. The cruet stands, too, are in many cases, unique with high cathedral and choir-screen frames, some incorporated to hold either a fork or tongs for serving. The Gibson House is at 5172 Yonge Street, directly behind Willowdale Post Office. Hours are 9:30 am to 5 pm Monday to Saturday, noon to 5 pm Sunday. Admission is
