

Canadian Jumping Derby New Venture For Local Riders

To improve competition and groom its riders for future international meets, the Canadian Equestrian Team has a new venture that may become an annual event.

The first Canadian jumping derby was held at Elderberry Hill on Sunday of last week. It was a very tough course and two top mounts, Adanac and Scotch Valley were tied for first place after a field of 20 jumpers completed the course. The course showed 24 natural and slow rink obstacles on a 1-mile course of hilly terrain.

Jim Elder, host of the event, took the overall victory on Adanac, while Mofat Dunlap of Newmarket was runner-up. Elder received the Courvoisier Trophy.

The national junior championship went to 14-year-old Kim Kirton of London, riding Beefeater, ahead of Missy Clark of East Aurora, N.Y. on Habit, and Gordon Suttcliffe of Toronto on Pennlehill.

The modified sweepstakes placed Denis Lefebvre of St. Adele, Quebec on Billy Moran as first, followed by Jim Elder on Anahai and Terry Leibel of Willowdale on Your Move.

The Owner jumper classic had David Pascoe of Alliston riding Shoe Mac out in front with Pam Richardson of King on Another Year second, and Sue Campbell of Mississauga on Mia third.
