Cones from evergreen trees are sent there from all parts of the province. The students learned how the cones are prepared and handled to extract the seeds. After watching this interesting process, they saw slides on how to graph evergreen trees. For lunch they all went to Springwater Park where they had a quick look through the zoo. The afternoon was spent at the government nursery at Midhurst. Here they became familiar with the process of preparing the soil and planting the evergreen seeds. They studied the different stages of growth and the ways the young plants are protected from the elements. It is interesting to note that seeds for replanting are always sent back to the area of the province the cones came from.

The First Richvale Brownie Pack had a Halloween Party on Monday night last week at Ross Doan Public School. They had a costume parade, apple bobbing and a pumpkin carving contest. They also did cup cake decorating, sang songs and made up a Halloween story. It was a great evening for all.
