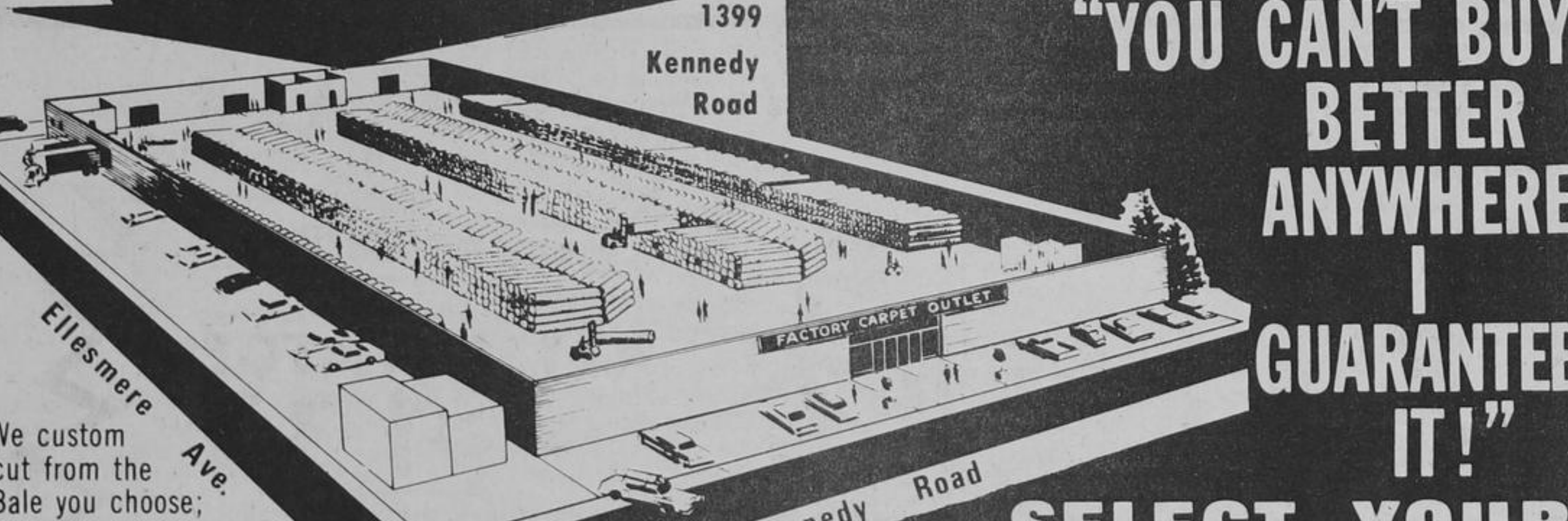
Maurice Ursini and his partner Pat Combdon (seen above) cut a mean rug to take the championship in the jive contest during the evening.
