

## Nice News York Central auxiliary will give hospital \$20,000 tonight

York Central Hospital Auxiliary will be presenting a cheque for \$20,000 to Hospital Administrator James Hepburn tonight.

The presentation will be made at the auxiliary's annual meeting at Summit View Gardens Restaurant, Yonge Street, Richmond Hill.

The auxiliary's main money-making projects are the White Rose Gift Shop in the lobby at the hospital, the annual Pub Night and the White Rose dinner dance.

In addition, each of the 12 YCHA branches has its own fund-raising projects: card parties, fashion shows, quilt raffles, teas, house tours, etc. The proceeds all go into the main fund to provide improved services to patients.

**Buy equipment**  
Most of the money will be used to purchase much-needed equipment for the greatly expanded X-ray and physiotherapy departments in the new Langstaff wing at York Central which opened in December.

Another important feature of this evening's meeting will be a presentation by Dr. John Blakely, chief of medicine and director of coronary care at York Central.

Dr. Blakely is also a research fellow and consultant at the coronary care unit at Sunnybrook Hospital and an assistant professor in the faculty of medicine at the University of Toronto. He will describe the new coronary care unit and how it operates.

**Flying start**  
The auxiliary is

already off to a flying start in its aim to raise even more money this year. Tickets for its Pub Night next week are sold out.

A candlelight and wine party is scheduled for March 19 and there will be fashion shows in one of the hospital's lecture rooms April 15 and 16.

This year's White Rose dinner dance will take place May 10 at the new Prince Hotel, and the new gift shop — twice as large, serving twice as many visitors to twice as many patients — is expected to net twice as much in profit.

When renovations to the original hospital building are completed this year there will be more patients moving in and more services to provide and more equipment to buy. The auxiliary intends to be prepared.

## Committee appointments

Recent newspaper advertisements placed by the Town of Richmond Hill asking for volunteers willing to serve on town committees brought an excellent response.

Twenty-one residents from every section of the municipality indicated a wish to serve on the parks and recreation committee.

14 applied for two openings on the committee of adjustment and 11 for the 12-member civic improvement committee.

A vote by council members on a points rating basis resulted in the following appointments:

**Parks & Recreation:** Robert Sarazin, 340 North Taylor Mills, Ward 1; Glen Philip, 378 Osiris Drive, Ward 2; Robert McKee, 286 Palmer Avenue, Ward 3; Russell Tilt, 25 Bridgford Street, Ward 4; Russell Newman, Wilcox Road, Ward 5; Terry Yuzwak, 121 Springhead Gardens, Ward 6.

Also on the parks and recreation committee will be four councillors: Chairman Al Duffy, Vice-Chairman William Corcoran, Mike Burnie and Andy Chateauvert.

**Committee of Adjustment:** The committee is composed of five members — three appointed one year for a two-year term and two appointed the next year for a two year term. The two members whose term of office was up this year were Tom Graham and Doug Higgins. Both indicated they were willing to serve again. There were 12 new applicants.

The new appointees will be Robert Wright, 366 South Taylor Mills Road (Ward 1); and William Vent, 76 Harding Boulevard (Ward 3); They will join John MacDiarmid, Vern Plante and William Ruttle on the five-man board.

**Civic Improvement Committee:** Named to this committee are Sam Hall and Eric George for Ward 1, William Mirrlees and Stephen Mills for Ward 2, Jack Major and Mrs. Suzanne Stoner for Ward 3, Judge James Butler for Ward 4, Jack Blythe and Mrs. Marjorie Lyon for Ward 5, S.A. Langhammer and Mrs. Shirley Stanley for Ward 6. Mayor David Schiller will name a second representative for Ward 4 at an early date.

Cam Smith was re-appointed to the library board for a three year term. Mayor David Schiller announced he will be a member of this board (by statute) with Regional Councillor Lois Hancey as alternate.

The unexpired term of Mrs. Barbara Cox, who has resigned, was not filled. It was agreed to advertise for volunteers to serve on this board.

Also to be filled is the third appointment of fence viewer. This will also be advertised, it was decided. The two fence viewers named were Arnold Mortonson and Wes Clarke.

Fred Bovaird was named weed inspector on the recommendation of the works commissioner.
