Pound chairs conservation, recreation task force Planning Commissioner

Murray Pound of York Region has been invited to chair a provincial task force to establish a co-ordinated policy for public acquisition of conservation and recreation lands. The region's planning committee has approved ac-

ceptance of this invitation. York will be the focus for the project with specific emphasis on the use and acquisition of open space lands in the Oak Ridges Moraine.

Mr. Pound has been greatly concerned about the preservation of the moraine, which could be very alnerable to unrestricted

development. He says the task force concept grew out of York's frustrations in trying to buy reforestation lands. Existing provincial grant policies are "a total

Short of money Because of lack of funds, York has been unable to buy as much land as it would like for reforestation, Pound told the region's planning committee. He recalled he lobbied on behalf of the region for a change in policy and the task force is the result.

The provincial govern-

funds for acquisition of open space near urban areas-a subject which will be considered by the task force. A co-ordinated policy for preservation and acquisition of open space will also be considered.

At present such acquisitions are made by municipalities and conservation authorities with prices, policies and priorities varying from one agency to another.

Other members of the task force will be Gordon Pyzer, resources manager of the South Lake Simcoe Conservation Authority; representatives of the

Metro Conservation Authority and the province; plus observers from the Regions of Peel and Durham.




