York Regional Camera Club had a record attendance of 40 members and guests at its last meeting when Mrs. Mary Ferguson presented a slide show on nature photography.

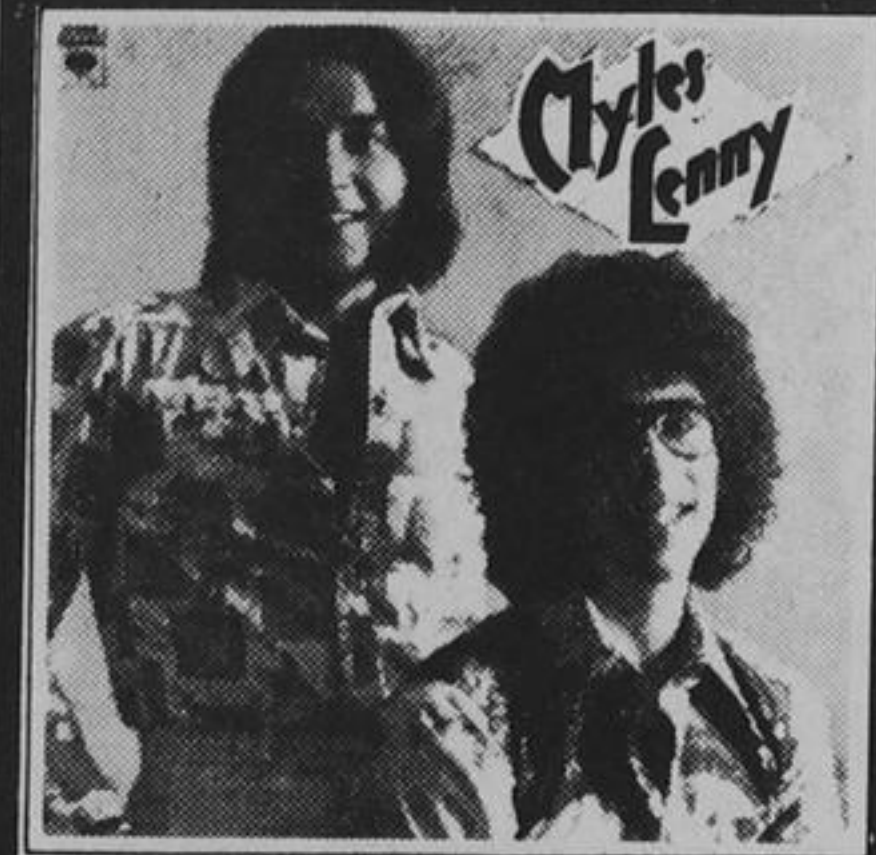
An active member of the Toronto Guild for Color Photography as well as competitor, judge and

RC board is hiring junior high staff

When York Region Roman Catholic School Board opens its first junior high school in September at St. Robert's School on Leslie Street in the Thornhill area, it is expected about 25 teachers will be needed for the estimated 300 students expected in grade 9.

Hiring of these teachers has already begun, Director of Education John Zupancic reported at the February 4 board meeting.

Principal Larry Garvey says he hopes to have half the required staff by March, the traditional time of hiring.

Garvey is holding scheduled meetings throughout the region with parents of new students to explain the programs which will be offered by the new junior high school.

He is also preparing a hand-book describing courses and the credit system planned. This hand-book will go to all grade 8 students in the system.
