OPP Report

Young sisters hurt in crash

Three young sisters were injured when they were in collision with a car while crossing Highway 7 at 8th Avenue in Woodbridge last week, it was reported by the Oak Ridges detachment of Ontario Provincial Police.

Wendy, 10, Linda, 9, and Yverlea Robertson, 6, of Kipling Avenue, Woodbridge all received minor injuries in the accident.

Driver of the car was Domenico Ferrone, Rainbow Drive, Woodbridge, who was making a left turn at the time.

All the accidents investigated by the OPP, didn't involve people.

A wolf was struck by a car and killed on Highway 11, north of Bloomington Road.

The carcass was turned over to the Ministry of Natural Resources for disposal.

The OPP also co-operated with Pennsylvania State Police and brought about the arrest of two people who were wanted for the theft of a trailer camper, a coin collection and a quantity of firearms.

The suspects were located in Sibbald Provincial Park by Constable Larry Hem-

bruff of the Oak Ridges detachment, who arrested them and also confiscated the camper and some firearms.
