

**\$5,000 for community education too little**

York County Board of Education this week received notice that it had been given a total of \$5,000 in community education grants from the provincial government.

But for Vice-chairman Craig Cribar of Newmarket, that wasn't enough.

The board received \$3,250 for a two-day seminar; all regional agency service; and \$1,750 for a pilot project: Lake Wilcox community.

A total of 15 grants for boards in the Central Ontario Region, going from the York board's low of \$1,750 to eight maximum grants of \$10,000, were handed out.

"Looking down the list I see many boards got requests we asked for and didn't get," Cribar said.

"Why they got \$10,000 and we didn't, I don't know. I'd like to see what kind of a proposal went in from here."

**Short shrift**

He said the Lake Wilcox proposal was for \$10,000, "but all we got was short shrift. So I wonder at the type of presentation we're making."

He said the board had "better figure out a way of getting to them. I'm getting tired of saying we're going to do something and not getting anywhere."

"Any suggestions as to what we might do with a report?" asked Chairman Don Sim.

Neither his profession nor his mood would allow him to reply to that, said Cribar, who is a Presbyterian minister.

Trustee Gary Adamson of Markham said the grants were "an example of what happens when you don't follow what goes on" in the ministry of education.

There was nothing they could do right now, but in the future they should make sure various "criteria were met".

**Something right**

Trustee Robert Houghton of Richmond Hill didn't see the matter as all so one sided.

"Somebody must have done something right to get \$5,000," said Mr. Houghton. "Some didn't get anything."

Trustee Donald Cousens of Markham was another who saw it differently.

Vice-chairman Cribar had "run off at the mouth," he said and he found it "up-setting."

"I wonder how much research he did," Cousens said. "He shouldn't point a finger and make judgments that may not be true."

Taking its cue from the chairman, the board agreed the chairman's committee should consider all comments and "take positive action on the committee use of grants well in advance of the date" of application.
