**Starting telephone crisis centre**

Telecare, a 24-hour telephone crisis centre, is being formed in York Region.

It will be operated by trained lay personnel and is expected to start in December.

Telecare will co-operate with local area services and professionals who will be on call at all times to handle emergencies or to refer distressed families to the appropriate agencies.

Group training sessions of 50 hours of lectures, discussion, role playing and practice counselling will begin in September.

Volunteers will be assessed by professionals who will then provide apprenticeship counselling.

According to Publicity Chairman Mrs. Flo Urry of King Township the need for such a centre in York Region has been proven.

"It will be a caring, listening and friendly telephone centre," she said.

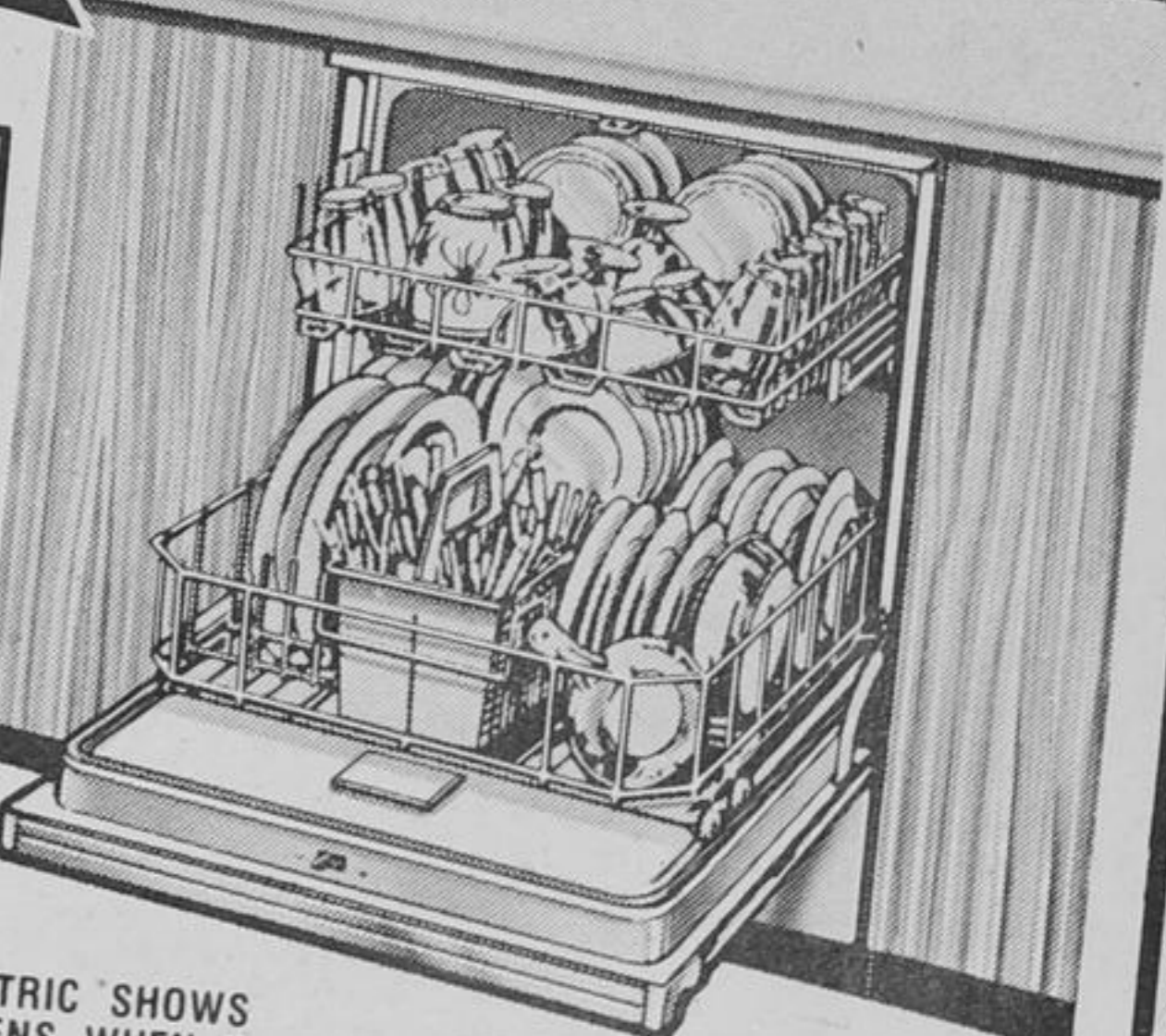
